Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time (A)

From the Desk of Rev. Msgr. Hugh J. Corrigan:

On Wednesday, February 1, I will celebrate my 30th anniversary as pastor of St. Mary's. When I was planning to write a history of the parish (1848-2016), I asked myself what I would write about my years as pastor. It eventually grew into ten chapters. I was surprised to find how much of my time and energy was expended in making sure that our church would remain a "sacred place". When I was first ordained in 1963, the physical renovation of a church building was low on my list of important things to do. When my first parish church burned down, I changed my mind. I realized how important a church building can be, especially to a Catholic community. You can read my reflections on this subject in chapter 22 of my book. Now that I am near the end of my tenure at St. Mary's (I will retire on July 1, 2018), there is one last major renovation of the church to be accomplished. Thanks to the new Archdiocesan Campaign of "Renew + Rebuild" we have been given the opportunity to renew and rebuild our magnificent stained glass windows. Installed in 1891 they are magnificent. Without them, St. Mary's would be greatly diminished as a "sacred place". So I ask you to be generous as our parishioners have been in the past e.g. capital improvement campaigns in 1984, 1991, 1998, and 2007. You can read the names of past donors on the four plaques in the foyer of our church. We will add one more plaque with hopefully, your name on it in 2018. Today we will conduct an in-pew sign up for those who have not yet made their pledges.
