**TODAY'S READINGS**

**First Reading: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a**

Moses reminds the Israelites that when they were starving in the desert, the Lord fed them with "manna" -- a food not known to them.

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 10:16-17**

Paul points out to the Corinthians that through the sharing of the cup and the breaking of the bread, they are all one in Christ Jesus.

**Gospel: John 6:51-58**

After Jesus feeds the five thousand people with barley loaves and fishes, he tries to make them understand the significance and the meaning of what he has done. He tells them, in mysterious and beautiful words, that the bread he gives is his flesh and says, "I myself am the living bread... If anyone eats this bread, he shall live forever."

**HIS WORD TODAY**

**"Brothers and sisters: The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because the loaf of bread is one we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf."**

The simple questions St. Paul asked his Christian community at Corinth are directed to us on this great day for our Catholic community. The danger of routinely approaching the altar and receiving the Eucharist is shaken as we read his important questions.

People wait hours to catch a glimpse of a hero, a star or idol. Many thousands gather in St. Peter's square weekly to see the Holy Father, hear his message and receive his blessing. But every time we meet for mass, Jesus is present in the gift of the Eucharist. He is present for adoration in the tabernacle, waiting for our praise and thanksgiving. Jesus is truly present in this sacrament for He wanted to remain with us, and this is the way He chose to be here.

May we be reminded of this great gift of His presence as we enter our church. May we teach our children the need for respect and reverence as we celebrate each Mass.

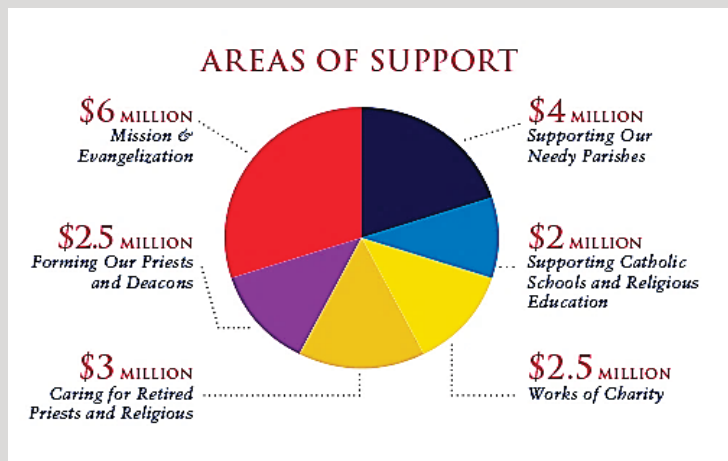

**Official Statement of the Administrator  
for the Parishioners of the Church of St. Mary-St. Joseph**

Dear Parishioners,

I would like to advise you about a meeting that was held at Saint Joseph Seminary on June 9, at the direction of Cardinal Dolan. Representatives of both parishes were present. Those in attendance were asked to consider a proposal from the cardinal that would merge the parishes of Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Saint Mary and Saint Joseph. Under this proposal, both churches would remain open, with Masses and sacraments celebrated at both locations. This proposal also calls for uniting the administration of the parishes with one pastor, one set of trustees, one parish council, and finance council. Discussions concerning this proposal are under way and we will keep you informed as they progress and when a decision is made within the next few months.

As part of our archdiocesan planning process, *Making All Things New*, Cardinal Dolan has announced that all parishes will be evaluated every 2 years. The proposal that he has presented, and is asking us to consider, is the result of that evaluation. The goal is to provide for the spiritual welfare of our people and to strengthen our parish as a vibrant faith community for the years to come.

We pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us in the midst of these deliberations.

Estimados Feligreses,

Me gustaría informarle sobre una reunión que se celebró en el Seminario San José el 9 de junio, bajo la dirección del cardenal Dolan. Representantes de ambas parroquias estaban presentes. A los asistentes se les pidió que consideraran una propuesta del cardenal que fusionaría las parroquias de Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo y Santa María y San José. Bajo esta propuesta, ambas iglesias permanecerían abiertas, con las misas y los sacramentos celebrados en ambos lugares. Esta propuesta también requiere unir la administración de las parroquias con un pastor, un conjunto de fideicomisarios, un consejo parroquial y el consejo de finanzas. Los debates sobre esta propuesta están en marcha y los mantendremos informados a medida que avancen y cuando se tome una decisión dentro de los próximos meses.

Como parte de nuestro proceso de planificación arquidiocesana, *Making All Things New*, el Cardenal Dolan ha anunciado que todas las parroquias serán evaluadas cada dos años. La propuesta que ha presentado, y nos pide que consideremos, es el resultado de esa evaluación. El objetivo es proveer el bienestar espiritual de nuestra gente y fortalecer nuestra parroquia como una vibrante comunidad de fe para los próximos años.

Oramos para que el Espíritu Santo nos guíe en medio de estas deliberaciones.

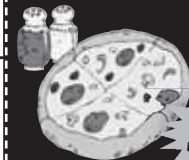
