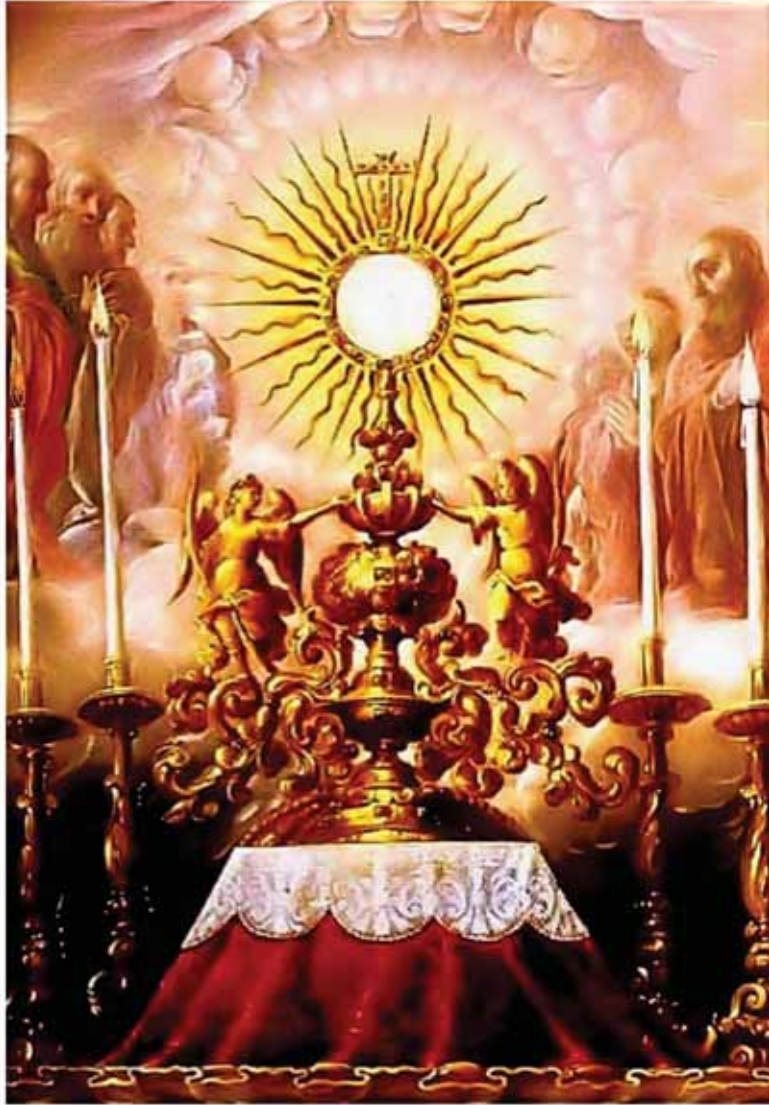

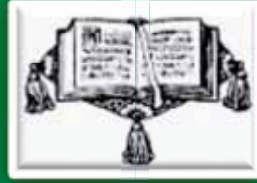

“Priests have received a power which God has given neither to angels nor to archangels. TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: II Kings 4:42-44

A man brought twenty loaves of bread to Elisha the prophet, who told his servant to distribute it to the people. The servant asked how he could offer twenty loaves to one hundred people. Elisha replied that God had said, "They shall eat and there shall be some left over." After all the people had eaten, there was bread left over as God had said.

Second Reading: Ephesians 4:1-6

Paul implores the Ephesians to live a life worthy of their calling by preserving unity among all of Christ's followers. He reminds them that there is one body, one Spirit, and one God who works through all people.

Gospel: John 6:1-15

Jesus fed a crowd of five thousand people with five loaves of bread and a couple of dried fish. After everyone present had enough to eat, twelve baskets of leftover bread were collected. Jesus then realized the people would want to make him king so he fled alone.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

"But his servants objected, 'How can I set this before a hundred people?' Elisha insisted, 'Give it to the people to eat, for thus says the Lord, they shall eat and there shall be some left over.' And when they had eaten, there was some left over, as the Lord had said... When Jesus raised his eyes and saw that a large crowd was coming to him, he said to Philip 'Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?' He said this to test him."

The selections from the book of Kings and from Mark are quite similar, - a hungry people, a compassionate prophet and a tremendous sign. May we move from the first testament and the mountain miracle to today.

People today are starving throughout the world. Wasteful living traps us and blinds us to this reality. Community food banks, parish pantries, Catholic Relief Services address countless needs. We are asked to respond. We bring not the twenty barley loaves, but what has been offered to us as gift. We are asked to give not of our surplus, but of our selves.

There is another hunger as well, a hunger for the Lord. How many are seeking, and will find His satisfaction, only through our word, our example. Who fed you, bringing the Lord to you? Are you ready to be like the tested Philip and extend your hand of compassion? Maybe I can be the boy Andrew presented and give something of myself.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura: 2 Reyes 4:42-44

Un hombre trajo veinte panes a Eliseo, quien ordenó a su sirviente distribuirlos entre la gente. El sirviente preguntó cómo podía distribuir veinte panes entre cien personas. Eliseo replicó que Dios había dicho "que comerán y habrá de sobra". Después de que la gente comió, había pan de sobra como Dios había dicho.

Segunda Lectura: Efesios 4:1-6

Pablo le implora a los efesios a vivir una vida digna de su llamado, preservando unidad entre los seguidores de Cristo. Les recuerda que hay un solo cuerpo, un Espíritu, y un Dios que trabaja a través de toda la gente.

Evangelio: San Juan 6:1-15

Jesús alimentó a una multitud de cinco mil personas con cinco hogazas de pan y un par de pescados secos. Luego que todos los presentes habían comido, se recolectaron doce canastas de pan que sobró. Jesús se dió cuenta entonces de que la gente quería hacerlo rey, por lo que se alejó a solas.

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

"Su servidor objetó: '¿Cómo voy a dar esto a cien hombres?' Eliseo dijo: 'Dáselo a la gente para que coman, porque así dice el Señor: Comerán y sobrarán.' Se los dio, comieron y dejaron de sobra, según la palabra del Señor... Al levantar Jesús los ojos y ver que venía hacia él mucha gente, dice a Felipe: '¿Donde vamos a comprar panes para que coman éstos?' Se lo decía para probarle, porque él sabía lo que iba a hacer."

Las lecturas del libro de Reyes y de San Marcos son muy similares: una multitud hambrienta, un profeta compasivo y una señal maravillosa. Que podamos pasar del antiguo testamento y el milagro del monte a hoy.

La gente hoy pasa hambrienta en el mundo entero. Nosotros estamos atrapados en tanto desperdicio que nos ciega a la realidad. Bancos de comida de las comunidades, alacenas de parroquias, Servicios de Alivio Católicos ayudan de forma incontable. Se nos pide responder. Traemos no los veinte panes de cebada, sino lo que se nos ha ofrecido como un don. Se nos pide no dar lo que nos sobra, sino de nosotros mismos.

Hay otro tipo de hambre, el hambre por el Señor. Cuántos buscan y encontrarán Su satisfacción sólo a través de nuestra palabra y ejemplo. ¿Quién lo alimentó a usted, lo trajo al Señor? ¿Está listo para ser probado como Felipe y extender su mano compasiva? Quizá, como el muchacho que Andrés presentó, pueda yo dar algo de mí mismo.

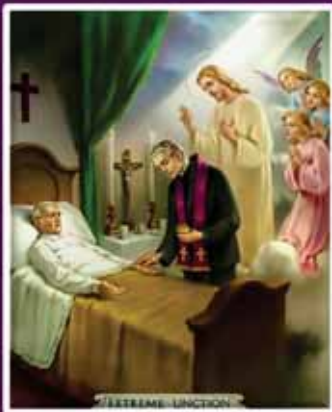

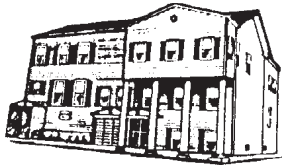
