The Transfiguration of the Lord

MEANING OF THE WORD "TRANSFIGURATION"

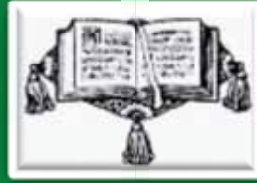
- The word "transfiguration" comes from the Latin roots *trans-* ("across") and *figura* ("form, shape"). It thus signifies a change of form or appearance.
- This is what happened to Jesus in the event known as the Transfiguration: His appearance changed and became glorious.
- Before looking at the Transfiguration itself, it's important that we look at what happened immediately before it in Luke's Gospel.

EVENTS LEADING TO THE TRANSFIGURATION?

- In Luke 9:27, at the end of a speech to the twelve apostles, Jesus adds, enigmatically:
 - "There are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the kingdom of God."
 - This has often been taken as a prophecy that the end of the world would occur before the first generation of Christians died out.
 - The phrase "kingdom of God" can also refer to other things, though, including the Church--the outward expression of God's invisible kingdom.
 - The kingdom is embodied in Christ himself and thus might be "seen" if Christ were to manifest it in an unusual way, even in his own earthly life.

REASON FOR THE TRANSFIGURATION

- The Catechism explains it this way:
 - Christ's Transfiguration aims at strengthening the apostles' faith in anticipation of his Passion: the ascent onto the 'high mountain' prepares for the ascent to Calvary.
 - Christ, Head of the Church, manifests what his Body contains and radiates in the sacraments: 'the hope of glory' [CCC 568].



TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15

The Israelites complain that Moses led them to the desert and there is no food for them there. Then the Lord told Moses he would rain down bread from heaven so the people might know that Al, the Lord, am your God. @ God did as he had promised and in the morning the people found the bread that he had given them.

Second Reading: Ephesians 4:17, 20-24

Paul tells the Ephesians that they must give up their old way of life and live in accordance with the truth that Christ has brought them. He reminds them to acquire a spiritual way of thinking, and to remember that they are made in God=s image and act accordingly.

Gospel: John 6:24-35

The people Jesus had fed on five loaves of bread follow him, and Jesus tells them they should not be looking for perishable food, but for spiritual food. The people want a sign that they should believe in him. He explains that he is the bread of life, and anyone who believes will not experience hunger or thirst. The people did not fully understand that he was speaking in the spiritual sense, and not of actual food.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

“Then the Lord said to Moses, ‘I will now rain down bread from heaven for you. Each day the people are to go out and gather their daily portion; thus will I test them to see if they follow my instructions or not.’... ‘You are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you.’”

For several weeks we will be listening to the gospel of John, chapter 6, teaching us of the great gift of the Eucharist. John’s gospel does not detail the institution of the Eucharist, but this chapter is telling us to listen and learn. We listen to Jesus telling once again ‘I am’. The church is pleading for us to treasure the gift of the Eucharist, not to treat this great sacrament casually or routinely. Am I ready to learn again?

From the earliest days of the church, even before the gospels were written, St. Paul wrote of the tradition telling his readers of the gift of the Eucharist. He asked that they be worthy and prepared to receive such a great gift. We sometimes rush into mass, and even worse rush out to busy ourselves with other important things. What can be more important than to spend a reflective moment, thanking our loving God for feeding us. Am I hungry for the Lord?

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura: Exodo 16:2-4, 12-15

Los israelitas se quejan de que Moisés los ha guiado al desierto y no hay comida para ellos allí. Entonces el Señor le dice a Moisés que hará que llueva pan del cielo para que el pueblo sepa que “yo, el Señor, soy su Dios”. Dios cumplió lo prometido y por la mañana el pueblo encontró el pan que El les había dado.

Segunda Lectura: Efesios 4:17, 20-24

San Pablo les dice a los efesios que deben abandonar su forma de vivir y comportarse de acuerdo a la verdad que Cristo les ha traído. Les recuerda adquirir una forma de pensar espiritual, y recordar que han sido hechos a semejanza de Dios y que deben comportarse de acuerdo a esto.

Evangelio: San Juan 6:24-35

La gente a la cual Jesús alimentó con cinco hogazas de pan lo siguió, y Jesús les dice que no deben buscar comida que se pudre, sino comida espiritual. La gente quiere ver una señal para creer en El. El les explica que El es el pan de vida, y que cualquiera que cree no pasará ni hambre ni sed. La gente no entendió completamente que de lo que estaba hablando era en el sentido espiritual, y no de comida.

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

“El Señor dijo a Moisés: ‘Mira, yo haré llover sobre ustedes pan del cielo; el pueblo saldrá a recoger cada día la porción diaria; así le pondré a prueba para ver si obedece o no mi ley’... ‘Ustedes me buscan, no porque han visto señales, sino porque han comido de los panes y se han saciado. Obrad, no por el alimento perecedero, sino por el alimento que permanece para vida eterna, el que les dará el Hijo del hombre.’”

Por varias semanas escucharemos el evangelio de San Juan, capítulo 6, que nos enseña el gran don de la Eucaristía. El evangelio de San Juan no explica detalladamente la institución de la Eucaristía, pero este capítulo nos pide que escuchemos y aprendamos. Escuchamos a Jesús decir de nuevo “Yo soy”. La iglesia nos ruega que atesoremos el don de la Eucaristía, a no tratar este gran sacramento casualmente o como rutinario. ¿Estoy listo a aprender de nuevo?

Desde los primeros días de la iglesia, aún antes de que se escribieran los evangelios, San Pablo escribió de la tradición al contarles a sus lectores sobre el don de la Eucaristía. Les pidió que se mantuvieran dignos y preparados para recibir semejante don. Muchas veces nos apresuramos a llegar a la misa, y peor aún, nos apresuramos a salir de allí a lidiar con otros asuntos. ¿Qué puede ser más importante que pasar un momento reflexionando, agradeciendo a nuestro amoroso Dios que nos alimenta? ¿Estoy hambriento del Señor?

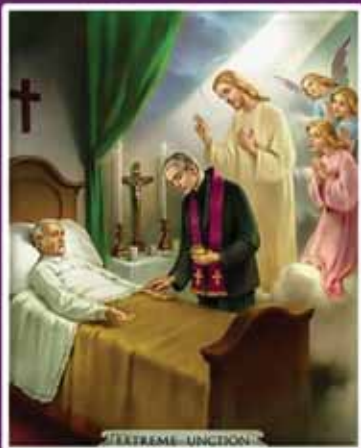

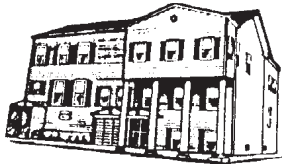
