There is much happening in the Catholic Church in the United States. In last weekend's bulletin, there was a blurb about National Migration Week, which ran from January 8-15. The purpose of National Migration Week is to draw our attention to the plight and unique circumstances of immigrants and refugees. The Catholic Church is a friend of immigrants and advocates for both a just and compassionate stance on immigration policy for our country.

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is from January 18-25. Unity among Christians has been a focus of the Church for almost 1,000 years. We know that our Lord desires all of his disciples to be reconciled and to work together to build His Kingdom. Such concord is the fruit of much effort, honest dialogue, and sincere prayer. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity opens our eyes to the fact that Catholic, Orthodox, and Protestant Christians are still called to the work of reconciliation.

Lastly, Nine Days for Life will begin on January 21 and conclude on January 29. These nine days are meant to highlight the beauty and dignity of all life, especially in light of the anniversary of the tragic Supreme Court decision *Roe v. Wade*. We know that more than 56 million lives have been lost to abortion since 1973, and the Church does not remain silent on this issue. Every person, from conception to natural death, is precious in the eyes of God. Therefore, we continue to work and pray for an end to violence committed against children in the womb.

The annual Respect Life Mass will be held on the following day, Monday, January 23, at 10:30 a.m. at St. Joseph Cathedral (212 E. Broad St.). Bishop Frederick Campbell will be the celebrant. After the Mass, the Roe Remembrance will take place at the Ohio Statehouse from noon to 1:00 p.m. This event is sponsored by Greater Columbus Right to Life. The program will be held in the Statehouse Atrium. Please allow extra time for new Statehouse security measures. Stickers, signs, and weapons are not permitted inside the Statehouse.
