As you already know, our parish is quite diverse. This means we have several ethnicities represented within our church family. It also means that there are several generations represented as well. We do not have an old church or a young church, but rather a multigenerational church. This is a tremendous blessing! We give thanks to God for making Christ the King a place where all people are welcome to grow in their faith and to share their gifts with each other.

Tending to the many needs of a multicultural, multigenerational church is challenging. There is a lot of room for us to improve! Some have commented that we are not doing enough to reach our older parishioners, especially those who are isolated due to the pandemic. With that in mind, we are going to begin again our phone tree ministry. Volunteers will soon be calling parishioners who are unable to come to church or participate in the life of the parish online. If you or anyone you know would like a phone call, please let us know. We want all of our parishioners to know and to feel that they belong to our church family, even if they cannot be present on Sunday.

Of course, we also are dedicating a lot of time and energy to our young parishioners. The sad reality is that the overwhelming majority of Catholics stop practicing their faith after they receive the sacrament of Confirmation. Confirmation has become a sacrament of graduation. After receiving this sacrament, many Catholics no longer nurture their relationship with Christ or the Church. As a part of our constant effort to reverse this trend, we are launching our PSR program and youth group next weekend. Our goal is to equip and encourage our young parishioners to embrace the call to follow Jesus in their daily lives, for the rest of their lives.
