**First Reading: Genesis 3:9-15**

The original couple blame each other for their sin. The snake instigated the whole matter, and so God punishes him severely. Then God puts enmity between the snake and "the woman", whom we know is Mary our Queen.

**Second Reading: II Corinthians 4:13 – 5:1**

Paul, empowered by the Spirit, has an active faith, and that is how he interprets his present suffering. He looks to an everlasting reward from God.

**Gospel: Mark 3:20-35**

Jesus is judged not only by His family, but also by the scribes as being "out of His mind," or probably possessed for what He is preaching. Jesus tells a crowd to expand their thinking and realize that His family is all those "who do God's will."

Dear Members and supporters of St. Boniface Parish,

Hope you are enjoying the spring/summer time. Thank you for your kind support to me personally and to our church.

I thought it is time that I give you some updates about our church finances.

While it may be difficult for many of you, here I am asking you to prayerfully consider an increase in your Sunday offerings as soon as possible. No matter how small or big the donation may be in accordance with your situation, it will be precious before the Lord.

Within the last couple of years many benevolent and dedicated members of our church have passed away to Rest in the Lord. Also several of the committed parishioners have moved elsewhere for obvious reasons.

On behalf of the parish, I thank all of you who are staying and wholeheartedly supporting our church by attendance, volunteering, prayers and generous financial offerings in different ways.

### **Here is a snap shot of our financial status; just the negative side FYI:**

In the year 2016- 2017 (Sept to Aug) we had a deficit of \$22,000. At that time we made an appeal to you for a one-time-donation. Thanks to your benevolent support we got through that year. Since Sept last year up to April this year, there is a net loss of \$58,000 .

For the current year 2017-2018 (Sept to Aug), our accountant has projected an added up deficit of \$73,000.

### **Good news:**

Our St. Mary's Syro-Malabar group has agreed towards an extra annual increase of 20,000 dollars from this month onwards. I appreciate their good will as they continue sharing our building space and pay us without any formal agreement until to date.

Additionally, those who can afford may give a large one-time donation to help balance our budget. In these difficult times, I humbly ask you to do your best to support our church's viability.
