Everyone welcome! Do not miss this beautiful opportunity for meditative prayer in Lent! Taize, which originated in France, is sung or chanted Christian prayer, with musical accompaniment, using simple repetitive words, refrains and melodies. “It is a time to rest in God, to let the words listened to and sung penetrate one’s being.” So says Brother John, a Taizé monk, in lectures and writings explaining what the service is all about.

There is no preaching, no teaching, no talk of sin or repentance or forgiveness. There is just this elegantly simple service: short chants, repeated several times as well as short Scripture readings or psalms, and silence, time to be at peace. A Taize prayer service is an hour. **ALL ARE WELCOME!**
