## LIFE – AND WORKS OF MERCY

This Friday, January 22, 2016, marks the 43<sup>rd</sup> anniversary of the appalling Supreme Court decision, Roe v. Wade. If you have ever read this decision, it is obvious that it is not only wrong, but bad law. It violates everything that our country was founded on, beginning with the right to life of every human person. And make no mistake, a preborn child in the womb is a person – they have the DNA and all that is required to classify them as a human. All they need is time to grow.

It is shocking that so many in our country hold that “terminating a pregnancy” (i.e. killing a child) is a fundamental **right** of a woman. What nonsense. Since when did anyone have the right to kill another human being simply because pregnancy was inconvenient or “unwanted.”

In this year of mercy, our parish is focusing each month on one of the corporal or spiritual works on mercy. For January, it is INSTRUCTING THE IGNORANT. So many people, especially young people, may not know how dearly the Church (and God) hold the gift of life. We can do much to instruct them. As Catholics, it is our obligation to stand up for life at all stages, from conception to natural death. We should speak up and speak out about the right to life of the unborn.

One way we can do that is to use our social and political voice. In this election year, it is possible to make our candidates know that only pro-life stances are acceptable to us and that they will not receive our vote if they are part of the Culture of Death. In addition, we need to ask our legislators to de-fund Planned Parenthood, the largest provider of so called “reproductive services” in the country. More children lose their lives because of this organization than any other. Also, we can do some homework on what businesses support the terrible evil of abortion through their donations. It may be impossible to boycott them all, but if each of us picked a few and stopped spending our money there, it would make a difference. In the back of the Main Church are postcards that you can fill out and place in the basket. These will be sent to our legislators to let them know we are serious about life issues. It may seem like an impossible task to get the Roe v. Wade legislation overturned, but if each of us takes one little step at a time, and maintains our devout prayers that hearts and minds will be changed, God will take care of the rest.

To mark the anniversary of the court decision, St. Patrick’s will be sending a busload of people to the March for Life in Washington D.C. The generosity of parishioners has made it possible for us to do this, and the most heartening thing is that 21 of our 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders from St. Patrick’s school will be going. The pro-life movement is getting younger all the time! Please consider going to the March. If you have never been, it is well worth the effort. If you can’t go to the March for Life, spend some time on Friday in serious prayer for an end to offenses against life in our country. Prayer is the best weapon we have.
