Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Matthew 25:31-46

On this final Sunday of the liturgical year the readings concern the end of time and Christ's role as king Jesus spoke to his disciples about separating sheep from goats, Ezekiel prophesied about the sheep God tends and then judges. Paul explained how at the end of time all will be brought to life and death will be destroyed. Finally, we hear Matthew's account of the Last Judgement. 
