World Grandparents & Elderly Day ~ July 25th



Pope Francis has established throughout the Church the celebration of the World Day for Grandparents and Elderly beginning in 2021 on

the **fourth Sunday of July** near the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus.

To express the closeness of God and of the church to every older person, Pope Francis has chosen “*I am with you always*” from the Gospel of Matthew as the theme for the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly.
