THE PASTOR'S CORNER

TAKING PRECAUTIONS

Having just received a letter from Monsignor LaMorte, the Vicar General of the Archdiocese, it seems prudent to address in the parish the potential threat posed by the Corona Virus (COVID-19). As of this writing, a second case has appeared in New York, and though that might seem hardly worth attention, the Corona Virus has spread in a number of countries outside of China. The World Health Organization has now confirmed the virus is more dangerous than the flu in individual cases, with a mortality rate of 3.4 percent (the average season flu strain kills about 0.1 percent of those infected). However, these numbers reflect mostly the death rate in China where the virus went unchecked (where the news about it was censored by the government). Conversely, it appears that the virus is more difficult to contract.

Different measures have been taken all over the United States in Catholic dioceses. Suspension of the exchange of peace prior to communion at Mass has been suggested as well as sharing of the cup and advising priests not to give the Eucharist on the tongue.

In any case, it seems good sense to take some measures in order to protect one another from the unintentional transmission of any illness. We recommend each year, during flu and cold season, to:

- Cover your mouth and nose with the crook of your arm or your hands if necessary when you sneeze or cough.
- Refrain from physical contact like shaking hands or embracing at any time during, before, or after Mass.
- Wash hands thoroughly before and after any contact.
- Stay home if you're not feeling well.

We will take likewise make sure that hand sanitizer dispensers are full and available; change the holy water fonts at the doors several times a week; encourage reception of communion in the hand (or making it easier for the minister to place the host on the tongue).

We have also begun at daily Mass and will do so on Sundays the practice of praying silently for our immediate neighbors at the exchange of peace rather than make any physical gesture. This I hope will help us break the habit of reaching out to our neighbor, which we almost do automatically. We also think it is a good idea not to shake the hands of the priests or deacons after Mass, since that puts us in physical contact with hundreds of people and makes us potential carriers.

Most importantly, may we pray that this health crisis, which impacts especially the elderly, the young, and the poor, be eradicated and that those involved in medical research or direct care of the sick may be assisted by grace in their important work.

May I also suggest prayer to St. Aloysius Gonzaga, the young Jesuit brother, who lost his life to the plague while caring for its victims or any other saint you might suggest.

GUIDELINES FOR FASTING AND ABSTINENCE:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. This is a serious matter within Church law.
- **FASTING** means only one full meal a day may be taken. Two smaller meals can be eaten to maintain physical strength but together they should not equal another full meal in quantity. Snacking between meals is not permitted. Catholics ages 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the

discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.
- **ABSTINENCE** forbids the eating of meat or poultry. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged to abstain on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent and continue to oblige throughout their lives. Those who are not specifically obliged to abstain from eating meat are urged to join in the discipline of abstaining to the extent that they are able.
- Remember **ALL FRIDAYS OF THE YEAR** are designated as days of penance during which we are encouraged to practice self-denial out of gratitude for the suffering and death Jesus accepted for us.
