Holy Catholic Church teaches, because You have

revealed them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived. Amen.

Act of Hope

Oh my God, relying on Your infinite goodness and promises; I hope to obtain pardon of my sins, the help of Your grace, and life everlasting, through the merits of Jesus Christ, My Lord and Redeemer. Amen.
