LITURGY OF THE MASS - PART I: THE INTRODUCTORY RITES

"Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in their midst" (Mt 18:20).

Number 46 of *The General Instruction of the Roman Missal* addresses describes the Introductory Rites as:

The rites that precede the Liturgy of the Word, namely, the Entrance, the Greeting, the Penitential Act, the *Kyrie*, the *Gloria in excelsis* (*Glory to God in the highest*) and Collect (prayer), have a character of a beginning, an introduction, and a preparation.

Their purpose is to ensure that the faithful, who come together as one, establish communion and dispose themselves properly to listen to the Word of God and to celebrate the Eucharist worthily.

The people who gather come from all directions and are made up of all ages, races, a variety of economic circumstances and political outlooks. We are the great procession, the Church, the people of God. *"Christ is really present in the very assembly gathered in his name, in the person of the minister, in his word, and indeed substantially and uninterruptedly under the Eucharistic species."*

LITURGIA DE LA MISA – PARTE 1 – RITOES INICIALES

"Porque donde están dos o tres reunidos en mi nombre, allí estoy yo en medio de ellos." (Mateo 18:20).

Número 46 de la Institución General del Misal Romano describe los ritos introductorios como:

Los ritos que preceden a la liturgia de la Palabra, es decir, el canto de entrada, el saludo, el acto penitencial, el *Señor, ten piedad*, el *Gloria* y la oración colecta, tienen el carácter de exordio, introducción y preparación. La finalidad de estos ritos es hacer que los fieles reunidos constituyan una comunidad, y se dispongan a oír como conviene la Palabra de Dios y a celebrar dignamente la Eucaristía. **En algunas celebraciones que, según la norma de los libros litúrgicos, se unen con la Misa, los ritos iniciales se omiten o se realizan de manera peculiar.**

Reunir las personas que vienen de todas las direcciones y se componen de todas las edades, razas, una variedad de circunstancias económicas y las perspectivas políticas. Somos la gran procesión, la Iglesia, el pueblo de Dios. *"Cristo está realmente presente en la misma asamblea reunida en su nombre, en la persona del ministro, en su palabra, y de hecho sustancialmente y de forma ininterrumpida bajo las especies eucarísticas."* Constitución sobre la Sagrada Liturgia

Dear friends,

As we celebrated the great Solemnity of Pentecost last week, we saw how the Church was turned upside down by the Holy Spirit, filled with life, and sent forth to change the world. The Apostles immediately faced challenges. All that they feared as they huddled in the Upper Room: persecution, imprisonment, and death, very rapidly came to pass. Yet in the midst of this, the Church grew stronger. We can see in the experience of the Apostles a model for us as a parish.

As individuals, as members of a community, as Christians, all of us face immense challenges. We may well have fears for the future, fears as deep as those of the Apostles. Yet the Holy Spirit is still at work. He is not done with us. May he inspire us to go forth and carry out the call which we received from Christ himself at Baptism. May he fill us with life and the fire of faith.

Although impact of Pentecost has reverberated through millennia and continues to reverberate today, everything that occurred took place within a short distance of the Cenacle. It was a local event that changed the world. The same is true today. Local events matter. If it doesn't happen here in the local church, in the parish, among us, it isn't going to make much of a difference.

One of the challenges we face as a community is financial. Perhaps we have been much too complacent about our stewardship. Perhaps we have huddled too long in the Upper Room. After all, we have gotten along from year to year. In some years our expenses have been a little greater than our income, in other years, we have come out a little ahead. But expenses are increasing and our Sunday collection is not. Our financial situation is becoming much more difficult.

Now is the time to be bold in our support for the Church. Now is the time to allow the Holy Spirit to move us. Now is the time to open ourselves to the power of the Holy Spirit, to let the flame of the Spirit leap from head to head, from heart to heart.

In the months ahead, Fr. Lazo and I will both be encouraging you to truly tithe in your support for the Church. This month and next, the Finance Council will be working with me so that we have a viable budget for the new fiscal year and we will have detailed reports for you early in July. Please listen. To your pastor, to Fr. Lazo, to the Finance Council, and most importantly, to the Holy Spirit.

On this Feast of the Holy Trinity may you be blessed, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and may our fathers enjoy the love of their families on this Father's Day. Next weekend, on the Feast of Corpus Christi, I will be in St. Louis attending the annual conference of the US Association of Catholic Priests yet we will be united in the Body of Christ. Please pray for me as I do for you.

Queridos amigos,

Cuando celebramos la gran solemnidad de Pentecostés el domingo pasado, vimos cómo el Espíritu Santo puso de cabeza a la Iglesia y la envió a cambiar el mundo. Los apóstoles se enfrentaron de inmediato a los desafíos. Todo lo que temían mientras se acurrucaban en el Cenáculo - la persecución, el encarcelamiento y la muerte - sucedieron muy rápidamente. Sin embargo, en medio de esto, la Iglesia se hizo más fuerte. Podemos ver en la experiencia de los Apóstoles un modelo para nosotros como parroquia.

Como individuos, como miembros de una comunidad, como cristianos, todos nosotros enfrentamos inmensos desafíos. Es posible que tengamos temores por el futuro, temores tan profundos como los de los apóstoles. Sin embargo, el Espíritu Santo todavía está trabajando. Él no ha terminado con nosotros. Que él nos inspire a salir y llevar a cabo el llamado que recibimos de Cristo mismo en el Bautismo. Que nos llene de vida y del fuego de la fe.

Aunque el impacto de Pentecostés ha reverberado a través de milenios y continúa reverberando hoy, todo lo que ocurrió tuvo lugar a poca distancia del Cenáculo. Fue un evento local que cambió el mundo. Lo mismo es verdad hoy día. Los eventos locales son importantes. Si un movimiento no sucede aquí en la iglesia local, en la parroquia, entre nosotros, no va a hacer mucha diferencia.

Uno de los desafíos que enfrentamos como comunidad es financiero. Quizás hemos sido demasiado complacientes con nuestra responsabilidad. Quizás nos hemos acurrucado demasiado tiempo el Cenáculo. Después de todo, nos hemos llevado bien de un año a otro. En algunos años nuestros gastos han sido un poco más altos que nuestros ingresos, en otros años, hemos salido un poco por delante. Pero los gastos están aumentando año tras año y nuestra colección del domingo no. Nuestra situación financiera se está volviendo mucho más difícil.

Ahora es el momento de ser audaces en nuestro apoyo a la Iglesia. Ahora es el momento de permitir que el Espíritu Santo nos mueva. Ahora es el momento de abrirnos al poder del Espíritu Santo, de permitir que la llama del Espíritu salte de cabeza a cabeza, de corazón a corazón.

En los próximos meses, el Padre Lazo y yo los estaremos alentando a diezmar verdaderamente en su apoyo a la Iglesia. Este y el próximo mes, el Consejo de Finanzas trabajará conmigo para que tengamos un presupuesto viable para el nuevo año fiscal y tengamos informes detallados para usted al principio de julio. Por favor escucha - a su párroco, al Padre Lazo, al Consejo de Finanzas, y lo más importante, al Espíritu Santo.

En esta Fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad, sean bendecidos por el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo, y que nuestros padres disfruten del amor de sus familias en este Día del Padre. El próximo fin de semana, en la fiesta de Corpus Christi, estaré en St. Louis asistiendo a la conferencia anual de la Asociación de Sacerdotes Católicos de los Estados Unidos, pero nos uniremos en el Cuerpo de Cristo. Por favor oren por mí como lo hago por ustedes.

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Dear Young Adults and anyone else interested,
The Diocese of Laredo (300 miles away, 5 hour drive from Houston) is receiving about 1,500 immigrants per week and is in **urgent** need of volunteers **this summer! Volunteers that can commit for few days (3 to 6 days at the time) is what they are looking for.** They called me hoping that I could reach out to young adults or young adult communities and organizations that are looking for mission ground to work here in Texas. This is a great opportunity and they have a great need which is being labeled as a **Humanitarian Crisis.**

As of last week, Border Patrol and CBP agents have told the Laredo Diocese that they will be receiving 250 people a day to help reach their destinations with their family members. Every day, immigration agents come in 7 vans filled with 70 or more people coming from the border or another border city that is filled to capacity. These people come in and are vetted for any health concerns. From there these people are processed by Catholic Charities workers from the Diocese and some from other Dioceses in the US. This is no more than 2 people right now because of personnel resources. From there they go to a group of about no more than 3 people to call their relatives, whom will be welcoming them to their home, and will be purchasing their bus ticket to get to them. This is the most tedious work because the phones used to call are the same ones used to receive a call back. Even though they are in Laredo with Hispanics, they do not have a lot of Spanish speakers at personnel. They have about 3 or 4 people manning the phones

Those that come have papers to be here legally and are waiting for a court date. Where they go will be where their court day will take place. Once the process has been done, they are told when a shuttle bus will be available to them to go to the bus station or airport if needed. These migrants are fed with little personnel to help cook and serve items. They are given clothes that is being donated, and they are given the opportunity to shower and use restroom facilities. They usually work hard to get the migrants to leave the same day they arrive to our 'La Frontera' Facility, but they can house 70 people there in case some can only leave the next day. They have one other facility available as of now.

In summary, there is only a team of 8 people working there and 3 or 4 from Catholic Charities USA. A lot of help is still needed. Help needed:

- ** At least 5 volunteers that can come help. This can go all the way to 15 or more.
- ** Help is needed 7 days per week (you may go few days or entire week)
- ** Aid involves helping cooking, serving, and cleaning in the kitchen, helping man the area where the clothes is at and give order there, help the shower area circulate, help see that no one leaves the property and that no one unauthorized enters on foot, sorting donations. You don't need to speak Spanish for this.
- ** The biggest help would be Spanish speakers that can help with the phone calls too.
- ** Driving back and forward people to bus station and airport (shuttles are provided)
- ** **Volunteers will be accommodated with free lodging and food from the shelter will be provided.**

If some want to help with items, they are in great need of:

The Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston recommends to those young adults planning to volunteer to follow these guidelines:

- ** Must be older than 18 years old.
- ** Must have legal documents to travel (due to proximity to border -even though you will be in USA side).
- ** During your mission work, please do NOT cross the border to Mexico for any reason.
- ** Must comply with Safe Environment Policies (CMG Connect/Safe Haven training, previously VIRTUS)- Although we will be serving adults, some children may be present.
- ** Travel with an older adult, leader or ministry leader that has more experience on service projects or ministry.
- ** Fill out a liability/medical release form (attached to this email). Give a copy to your group leader and leave a copy with your parish.
- ** Let your pastor know your group will be going and give a courtesy call to the YACM office for us to know you will be going to help at 713-741-8778 (Monica Duran or email yacm@archgh.org)
- ** It is extremely important that no one crosses the border to Mexico under no circumstances.
