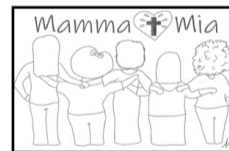

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading JER 38:4-6, 8-10

In those days, the princes said to the king: "Jeremiah ought to be put to death; he is demoralizing the soldiers who are left in this city, and all the people, by speaking such things to them; he is not interested in the welfare of our people, but in their ruin." King Zedekiah answered: "He is in your power"; for the king could do nothing with them. And so they took Jeremiah and threw him into the cistern of Prince Malchiah, which was in the quarters of the guard, letting him down with ropes. There was no water in the cistern, only mud, and Jeremiah sank into the mud. Ebed-melech, a court official, went there from the palace and said to him: "My lord king, these men have been at fault in all they have done to the prophet Jeremiah, casting him into the cistern. He will die of famine on the spot, for there is no more food in the city." Then the king ordered Ebed-melech the Cushite to take three men along with him, and draw the prophet Jeremiah out of the cistern before he should die.

Primera lectura Jer 38, 4-6. 8-10

Durante el sitio de Jerusalén, los jefes que tenían prisionero a Jeremías dijeron al rey: "Hay que matar a este hombre, porque las cosas que dice desmoralizan a los guerreros que quedan en esta ciudad y a todo el pueblo. Es evidente que no busca el bienestar del pueblo, sino su perdición". Respondió el rey Sedecías: "Lo tienen ya en sus manos y el rey no puede nada contra ustedes". 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Wow! May the fire of the Holy Spirit continue to burn brightly within you!

Last Sunday we had a "Red Envelope Collection". We asked every family and household to place a red envelope in the collection in addition to their normal offering. We asked you to reflect on your Stewardship. We asked you to put \$20 in the envelope knowing that it would mean sacrificing something this week. If you were struggling to provide for the needs of your family and already offering all that you could, we asked you to put nothing at all in the envelope.

Last Sunday, 211 or 70% of our families were able to give \$20 more. 92 families were not. Some of those 92 families may have given \$20 the previous Sunday in anticipation of our Red Envelope Collection. Those families gave in advance but were unable to give on Red Envelope Sunday. They may have recognized that while they would be able give \$20 more each month, they could not do so every Sunday.

In total, we received 437 envelopes, of which 75% contained \$20. The total for the Red Envelope Collection was \$7248.05. Our regular collections since July 1 have averaged slightly over \$9700. Last Sunday our regular collection was \$9036 which is close to average. This means that what you gave in the Red Envelope Collection was truly in addition to your usual offering. Combined, the 2 total \$16,284.05 which would provide all that we need as a parish if we would do this every Sunday.

A Professor of Liturgy once noted that most of our prayers begin by reminding God of all the good He has done for us and then asking Him to "Do it again!" God continues to answer our prayers, to bless us. Let us respond to His continuing care by "Doing it again." After reflecting upon your Stewardship, you know whether you can give \$20 more to the collection than in the past. Do it again! Every Sunday. Then we will be the parish we want to be. The parish we know we can be.

If you and your family were unable to give \$20 more, know that God acknowledges every true sacrifice, even the smallest, and He does not ask the impossible of us. If you are struggling, remember that the Lord is the Good Shepherd who never abandons His flock and that this community stands ready to help you in all that we can through our Social Ministry.

Thanks be to God who lights up the hearts of His people!

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

¡Guau! ¡Que el fuego del Espíritu Santo continúe ardiendo brillantemente dentro de ustedes!

El domingo pasado tuvimos una "Colecta de Sobres Rojos". Pedimos a todas las familias y hogares que coloquen un sobre rojo en la colecta además de su ofrenda normal. Le pedimos que reflexione sobre su Corresponsabilidad. Le pedimos que pusiera \$20 en el sobre sabiendo que significaría sacrificar algo esta semana. Si estaba luchando por satisfacer las necesidades de su familia y ya ofrecía todo lo que podía, le pedimos que no pusiera nada en el sobre.

El domingo pasado, 211 o 70% de nuestras familias pudieron dar \$20 más. 92 familias no lo pudieron. Algunas de esas 92 familias pueden haber dado \$20 el domingo anterior en anticipación de nuestra Colecta de Sobres Rojos. Esas familias dieron por adelantado, pero no pudieron dar el domingo del Sobre Rojo. Es posible que hayan reconocido que si bien podrían dar \$20 más cada mes, no podrían hacerlo todos los domingos.

En total, recibimos 437 sobres, de los cuales el 75% contenía \$20. El total de la Colecta de Sobres Rojos fue de \$7248.05. Nuestras colectas regulares desde el 1 de julio han promediado un poco más de \$ 9700. El domingo pasado nuestra colecta regular fue de \$ 9036, que está cerca del promedio. Esto significa que lo que diste en Colecta de Sobres Rojos fue realmente además de su ofrenda habitual. Combinados, los 2 totalizan \$16,284.05 que proporcionarían todo lo que necesitamos como parroquia si hacemos esto todos los domingos.

Un profesor de liturgia señaló una vez que la mayoría de nuestras oraciones comienzan recordando a Dios todo el bien que ha hecho por nosotros y luego pidiéndole que "¡Hágalo de nuevo!" Dios continúa respondiendo nuestras oraciones, para bendecirnos. Respondamos a Su cuidado continuo al "hacerlo de nuevo". Después de reflexionar sobre su corresponsabilidad, usted sabe si puede dar \$20 más a la colecta que en el pasado. ¡Hazlo otra vez! Todos los domingos. Entonces seremos la parroquia que queremos ser. La parroquia que sabemos que podemos ser.

Si usted y su familia no pudieron dar \$20 más, sepan que Dios reconoce cada sacrificio verdadero, incluso el más pequeño, y no nos pide lo imposible. Si está luchando, recuerde que el Señor es el Buen Pastor que nunca abandona a Su rebaño y que esta comunidad está lista para ayudarlo en todo lo que podamos a través de nuestro Ministerio Social.

¡Gracias a Dios que ilumina los corazones de Su pueblo!

LITURGY...LIVE IT! (11)

LITURGY OF THE MASS - PART I: THE INTRODUCTORY RITES

The primary purpose of the introductory rites is for those assembled to “take on the form of a community and prepare themselves to listen to God’s word and celebrate the eucharist properly.” General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM, 24.) We continue with the Introductory Rites....

THE COLLECT (The Opening Prayer)

The Collect, or Opening Prayer completes the Introductory Rites of the Mass. Historically, it is thought that when people gathered together or were “collected” together, certain prayers were said. Pope Innocent III said that in the Collect prayer, the priest collects together the prayers of all the people.

Today, the priest invites all of us assembled to pray. A moment of silence is observed so that we may place ourselves in God’s presence and present our own prayers. Then the priest continues with the Collect Prayer.

“This prayer is literally a *collection* of all the intentions and favors we ask, from the Holy Father down to the smallest member of the Mystical Body. In it we ask God for blessings for the Church, for the Pope, for the people; we ask for grace and peace and prosperity, and we ask for all the things we so dearly need in the temporal order.” (CatholicCulture.org)

Our final response is Amen. Consider that this is your prayer, our prayer, the prayer at every mass all through the world. **If we consider the immensity of this prayer, how can we mumble an Amen at it’s conclusion?** Let us PRAY a robust, I believe you will answer me Lord, **AMEN!**

LITURGIA DE LA MISA – PARTE 1 – RITOS INICIALES

El propósito principal de los ritos introductorios es que aquellos que se reúnen “tomen la forma de una comunidad y se preparen para escuchar la Palabra de Dios y celebrar la Eucaristía adecuadamente”. Instrucción general del Misal Romano (GIRM, 24). Continuamos con los Ritos Iniciales....

ORACIÓN COLECTA (oración de apertura)

Oración Colecta, o la oración de apertura, completa los Ritos Iniciales de la misa. Históricamente, se cree que cuando las personas se reunían o eran "reunidas", se rezaban ciertas oraciones. El Papa Inocencio III dijo que en la oración Colecta, el sacerdote junta las oraciones de todas las personas.

Hoy, el sacerdote nos invita a todos nosotros reunidos a rezar. Se observa un momento de silencio para que podamos colocarnos en la presencia de Dios y presentar nuestras propias oraciones. Luego el sacerdote continúa con la oración colectiva.

“Esta oración es literalmente una colección de todas las intenciones y favores que pedimos, desde el Santo Padre hasta el miembro más pequeño del Cuerpo Místico. En él le pedimos a Dios bendiciones para la Iglesia, para el Papa, para el pueblo; pedimos gracia, paz y prosperidad, y pedimos todas las cosas que tanto necesitamos en el orden temporal ”. Nuestra respuesta final es Amén. Considera que esta es tu oración, nuestra oración, la oración en cada misa en todo el mundo. **Si consideramos la inmensidad de esta oración, ¿cómo podemos murmurar un Amén en su conclusión?** OREMOS un mensaje robusto, ¡creo que me responderás Señor, **AMÉN!**
