Ninetieth Sunday In Ordinary Time

August 13, 2017

When Jesus Commands You to Walk on Water, Do it!

The disciples were never more secure than when Jesus was in their midst. In the face of what would normally be scary, insecure or otherwise overwhelming circumstances – whether it be an unexpected thunderstorm or a crowd of over 15 thousand hungry people in need of being fed – if Jesus was there, there was no need to panic; no need to doubt because in the end, it would all work out!

So, we can certainly imagine that it was not with any great enthusiasm that the disciples complied with Jesus' command to "get into a boat and proceed to the other side" (Matt 14:22) – without him! Maybe that's why the scriptures say that Jesus "made them" get into the boat! When Jesus told them to go on ahead while he stays back to pray, we could easily imagine them saying something like, "Hey, Lord, we don't mind waiting for you. You just go on and chat with your Daddy in Heaven and we'll just hang out, maybe stop by a Starbucks and pick up a Latte or Cappuccino..." But Jesus insisted: "Get in the boat and meet me on the other side!" So what was the problem? Well, if you go back six chapters earlier in this same Gospel you'll notice that the last time that they went sailing a treacherous storm arose and they nearly drowned but for Jesus promptly putting the storm in its place with a word of command: "Quiet!" he said, "Be Still!" They didn't want to go out on the sea if Jesus was not going with them!

I remember not wanting to ride a bike without training wheels for the first time, but my mother insisted and I learned to ride the same day. I didn't want to jump in the deep water at the pool, but my swimming instructor made me do it and I discovered I could stay above the water without sinking. The moral is this: The only way you grow stronger in your faith is by practicing it! Jesus made them get in the boat and face their worst fear, the storm. He commanded Peter to get out of the boat and conquer the raging waters by literally walking over them. Only by facing the impossible situation do we discover first-hand that God can do the impossible! So, go where Jesus sends you and do what he tells you so that you too could be utterly amazed at what Christ is capable of in those who put their trust in him!
