FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Announcement from Bishop Gerald Walsh, Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of New York

In October 2016, The Archdiocese of New York launched the Independent Reconciliation and Compensation Program (IRCP), to assist victim-survivors of sexual abuse by a priest or deacon of the Archdiocese achieve a sense of resolution and healing for the suffering they have endured. Although the IRCP is administered by outside experts, Mr. Ken Feinberg and Ms. Camille Biros, the archdiocese also pledge that, if an allegation of abuse was brought concerning a priest or deacon who was still alive but had no previous complaints about him, the allegation would be reported to the proper District Attorney for whatever action they wished to take; it would also be handled according to archdiocesan protocol and procedure, which includes an investigation by the independent team of investigators, all former Federal agents, and reviewed by the Archdiocesan Lay Review Board, made up of judges and other attorneys, psychiatrists and psychologists, parents, child care experts, and others, who would render a decision on whether the allegation was credible and substantiated.

During the IRCP process, allegations of abuse were brought against Msgr. John Meehan who served at Saint Mary Church, in the merged Parish of Saint Mary-Our Lady of Mount Carmel, from 1992 to 2011. The Lay Review Board has concluded that the allegations were credible and substantiated. Msgr. Meehan has been suspended, and may not function or present himself as a priest. The Holy See will decide an appropriate penalty, which could include dismissal from the clerical state of imposing a life of prayer and penance.

Anuncio del Obispo Gerald Walsh, Obispo Auxiliar de la Arquidiócesis de Nueva York

En octubre de 2016, la Arquidiócesis de Nueva York lanzó el Programa de Reconciliación y Compensación Independiente (IRCP) para ayudar a las víctimas sobrevivientes de abuso sexual por parte de un sacerdote o diácono de la Arquidiócesis a lograr un sentido de resolución y curación por el sufrimiento que han sufrido. Aunque el IRCP es administrado por expertos externos, el Sr. Ken Feinberg y la Sra. Camille Biros, la arquidiócesis también promete que, si se presentó una acusación de abuso con respecto a un sacerdote o diácono que todavía vivía pero no tenía quejas previas sobre él, en la acusación se informaría al Fiscal del Distrito correspondiente para cualquier acción que desearan tomar; también sería un equipo independiente de investigadores, todos ex agentes federales, y revisado por la Junta de revisión laical de la Arquidiócesis, formada por jueces y otros abogados, psiquiatras y psicólogos, padres, expertos en cuidado infantil y otros, que tomarían una decisión sobre si la acusación era creíble y fundamentada.

Durante el proceso IRCP, se presentaron acusaciones de abuso contra Msgr. John Meehan quien sirvió en Santa María Iglesia, en la fusionada Parroquia de Santa María-Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo, de 1992 a 2011. La Junta de Revisión Laical ha concluido que las acusaciones son creíbles y sustanciadas. Msgr. Meehan ha sido suspendido y no puede funcionar ni presentarse como sacerdote. La Santa Sede decidirá una pena apropiada, que podría incluir el despido del estado clerical de imponer una vida de oración y penitencia.
