New Hymnals

After considerable review of a number of hymnals available for Catholic Worship, we decided on a new Hymnal for our Parish. The St. Augustine Hymnal is published by International Liturgy Publications (ILP). The hymnal offers 650 hymns, the Order of Mass, Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction. The reason behind the change is primarily the inclusion of all the Scripture readings for Sunday Mass, with all of their options. The present hymnal did not offer many of the options which was a cause of disappointment and confusion. Also, this is a permanent hardcover hymnal for our pews. It is more environmentally friendly because we are not changing and discarding books each year.

The hymnals are available as memorials. Inside the front cover of each book we can feature a memorial label with the name(s) of your loved one, or a donation label for your intentions.
