Plum Building Committee & Finance Advisory Council Meeting

To keep more parishioners informed and updated regarding projected improvement plans at Sts Peter & Paul, I submit the following synopsis of a meeting on October 23:

- The Parish has officially engaged the services of an Architect, James Recek
- The Building Committee and Finance Advisory Council met with him on Oct. 23, 6:30pm
- Renderings were presented for an Open Air Pavilion in front of the Parish Hall and thoroughly discussed. The Council approved these renderings in principal
- Also presented were plans for two ADA compliant restrooms with access from inside and outside of the Hall. These two projects would be undertaken together
- Working drawings for both will be bided projects. Bids will be obtained by the Architect and then be presented to the Diocese Building Committee for their recommendation to the Bishop for signature of contracts for construction.
- Discussion also focused on the interior Parish Hall “sound/noise” problem. Suggestions included acoustic ceiling tiles and softer floor surface. No decision was made of how to alleviate the problem.
- Discussions are ongoing for construction of a Cover for west side of the Hall and Interior remodeling upgrades. The Council appreciates the involvement and input from everyone in the Parish’s Master Plan for facility improvements.
- In other business, the Council approved a plan developed by Gene Kruppa to improve the drainage along the Cemetery roadway and to re-surface the road to all-weather status.
Mr. Kruppa will develop bid for the project from road contractors and oversee the project.
