2020 Rosary Congress



The 2020 Diocesan Rosary Congress will begin with an *opening Mass* at Our Lady of Victory Cathedral in Victoria and livestreamed at www.olvcathedral.org on Sunday, October 4, 6:00 pm. *Presentation on Marian Consecration* is Wednesday, October 7, 7pm on the Diocese of Victoria in Texas Facebook Page or at www.victoriadiocese.org. The Congress concludes on October 11. During this week, Bishop Cahill has asked that the faithful make a special effort to pray the Holy Rosary in the presence of our Eucharistic Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament for the following intentions: 1) an end to the coronavirus pandemic, 2) for hope, care and the safety of our families, 3) in reparation for the sin of indifference to the pain of others, and 4) in reparation

for the sins of priests and bishops in the scandals of the Church. Of course, if prayer in the presence of our Eucharistic Lord is not possible, the faithful may join in the Rosary Congress by praying their rosaries wherever and whenever they can. A binder with special Rosary Congress meditations for every mystery of the Holy Rosary will be available in the Adoration Chapel in Hostyn and in the church in Plum.
