Next Saturday, November 11, is the All Saints Academy annual Eaglefest Dinner and Auction in the Brophy Center at St. Jude Parish. The purpose of this event is to build community and to raise funds for the school. There will be a dinner and after the dinner an auction. During both hopefully people can both meet new people and reestablish old friendships that they already have. Usually every year, I am at Eaglefest to begin the dinner with a prayer, but this year I am not sure yet if I will be able to make it there. Obviously you who were at Mass last weekend or this weekend will know that I have been having some health issues. The story about this is that on Tuesday, October 24th, I had a gastroscopy and colonoscopy. The reason for having these tests is due to my personal and family health histories. I am on a schedule to have these tests every five years. This is the third time I have had them since I have been here at Blessed Sacrament (2005, 2012, 2017). This is the first time I have had trouble with the recovery. Although this time the test results came out fine, it seems that my body has not as it is not recovering very well from the invasive nature of the preparation and the tests themselves given my prior condition. My doctor has prescribed for me a really boring diet and rest. He also told me that I had to avoid any stress which we both agreed would not be accomplished until I stopped breathing given the world in which we live, and Msgr. Schneider's comments last Sunday about my disposition. So at this point, my doctor says that my gastro-intestinal tract will heal itself when it does, and until it does sufficiently do that you probably won't see me around in public. Also thank you for all of you who have asked about me and also for your many pravers.


