The 4600 Gulf Freeway location of Planned Parenthood is one of the largest abortion facilities in the world, and individuals and small groups have been praying regularly at the site for years. Our presence there is a powerful witness to the workers in the clinic as well as to the clients and passersby. Most people find it much less scary once they try it.

In Sharpstown we pray on the sidewalk across the street from a medical building where a doctor does abortions in his office. We have a clear legal right to be in the public right of way along the street, as long as we do not block any other pedestrians or any vehicles. While there may be some sidewalk counselors present who may try to approach those who are entering the building, 40 Days for Life volunteers are neither expected nor encouraged to do so. We are simply asking you to be a public witness as you pray. It is highly unlikely that anyone will take any action against you or even shout at you.
