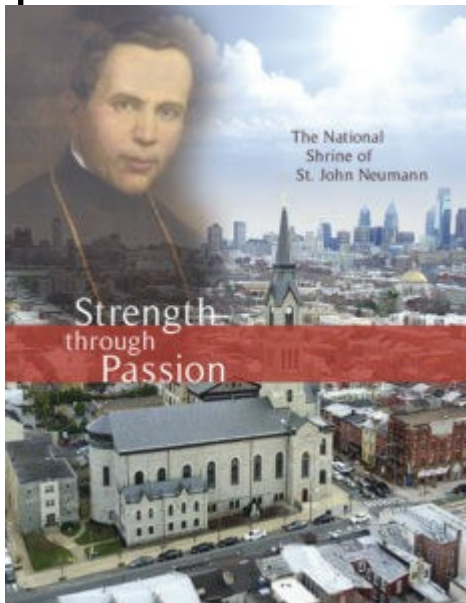


Caravan to the Shrine of St. John Neumann
