Comal County Emergency Services District #5 (CCESD#5) announces a land donation for new emergency services station to improve EMS service for the western Bulverde area.

The Bulverde area is experiencing significant growth, increasing the demand for emergency services in western Comal County. The need for a new station, located in the western area of Bulverde, was identified by CCESD#1, CCESD#4, CCESD#5 and Bulverde Spring Branch Emergency Services (BSBES) as a result of joint long-term planning efforts and past ISO studies. A new EMS station located in this area will improve emergency responsiveness in this area by reducing the time required to arrive on scene fully equipped. Accordingly, CCESD#5 initiated project development activities for Station #5 last year.

We are pleased to announce that Ronnie and Terry Urbanczyk, of Bulverde, have committed to donating the land needed to build Station #5, located on SH 46, about 5 miles west of US 281. CCESD#5 has agreed in principal to accept this donation, enabling us to move forward with the all aspects of Station #5 design and permitting. We will be working with the Urbanczyk's in the coming months to finalize and formally accept this donation.

Construction of Station #5 is scheduled to begin in 2021 and is expected to be in operation by the Spring of 2022.
