# July 2021 Operations Report

Initial call volume 392 up 38.52% over same month last year;

Up 29.49% YTD. Transport up 32.77%. Record transports this month at 187.

Department fractile showed some improvement despite a significant increase in volume. This is in part due to station 5 staffing having completed their initial FTEP and now assisting with call volume. Temporary station 5 is not open yet but staffing is being utilized.

Hospital diversions are causing issues. Closest facilities are not accepting patient and the ones that remain open have significant delays in patient placement. This delay has negatively impacted the ability of staff to get back in-service in a timely manner.

Department was 86.93%; Fire apparatus response 93.62%; EMS responses 85.37%.

Should be staffing station 5 mid-August.

Covid is on the rise, multiple patient transports.

Crew quarters areas at all stations remain locked down to all but duty staff. Meeting rooms are open for ESD meetings ONLY. Masks are encouraged, as of yet (8/3/21) not required. Station 1 Board is open to **meeting with 4 or less participants**. More than that may use the small classroom when available, max is 10.

Station 1 will require a mask to enter and must be worn until your destination room is entered and placed back on when leaving.

Crews are back to COVID testing at the start of their rotation. BSBES as had one positive with no apparent spread. Area departments have been hit pretty hard with as many as 6 out at one time.
