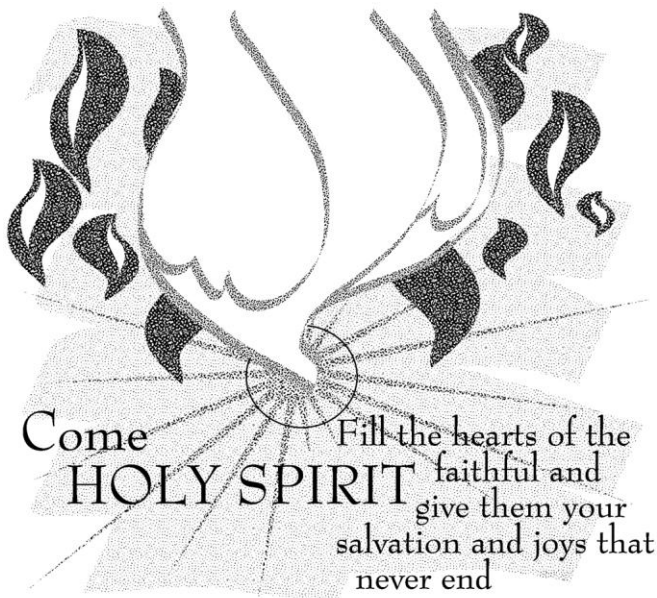


**Pentecost**  
**May 24, 2015**



**Reflection on the Scriptures**

"It was in one Spirit that all of us, whether Jew or Greek, slave or free, were baptized." —1 Corinthians 12:13

On Pentecost, after praying for nine days (see [Acts 1:14](#)), we "receive the Holy Spirit" ([John 20:22](#)). In fact, we are "filled with the Holy Spirit" ([Acts 2:4](#)). Better than that, we are baptized in the Spirit ([Acts 1:5](#)), that is, we are immersed in the Spirit. We not only drink the waters of the Spirit but, in a spiritual sense, we are under and stay under these waters.

Living under the waters of the Spirit is a new life. Naturally, when we go under water, we can't breathe, but, supernaturally, being under the waters of the Spirit is the only way we can breathe fully. However, we are tempted to come up out of the waters of the Spirit for another whiff of the polluted air of the world and the flesh. "The flesh lusts against the Spirit and the Spirit against the flesh" ([Galatians 5:17](#)). However, we must resist these temptations and stay immersed in the Holy Spirit. "When men have fled a polluted world by recognizing the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, and then are caught up and overcome in pollution once more, their last condition is worse than their first" ([2 Peter 2:20](#)).

On this Pentecost, take the plunge and live under the baptismal waters of the Holy Spirit.
