### ROL RESPONDS TO THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

- Temporarily suspended: Communion from the chalice, the Sign of Peace, and use of holy water fonts. Communion in the hand is strongly encouraged.
- Individual confession will take place in the nave of the church at the usual time.
- Ministry to the Homebound is temporarily suspended. In lieu of visits, our ministers will conduct weekly welfare checks by telephone.
- Sunday refreshments after Masses are also suspended.
- Lenten Movie Night, Friday, March 20 is cancelled.
- Those who are feeling sick have no obligation to attend Mass and we ask that you stay at home until you are fully recovered.
- A parishioner who feels well but has a reasonable fear of contracting illness is also dispensed from their Sunday obligation per Bishop Silva's March 12, 2020 guidance.
- Parents who are concerned about their children attending Children's Ministry, EDGE, or Life Teen may keep their children at home. It will be considered an excused absence.

### BISHOP SILVA'S PRAYER DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC
