CHURCH RE-OPENING

EFFECTIVE MAY 30, 2020

IN ORDER TO MINIMIZE THE RISK OF INFECTION & PROTECT ALL WHO ATTEND, WE HAVE PUT THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES IN PLACE:

MASSES

- Weekend Mass schedule will remain the same
 - Saturday 5:15 PM
 - Sunday 7:30 AM, 9:30 AM, 6:00 PM
- Weekday Masses
 - Mon - Fri 6:00 PM
 - Saturday morning mass will resume at a later date
- Max Capacity per Mass: 120 people



MASS RESERVATIONS ON EVENTBRITE.COM

- Reservations will open on **Tuesdays at 12 noon**
- 1 seat = 1 headcount
- Attendance at Mass will be limited to those we can accommodate with the 6 ft physical distancing.
- To manage attendance, you will need to register on Eventbrite.com to reserve your seat.
 - Only those who have reserved their seat on Eventbrite will be allowed to attend Mass.
- Please print the reservation or take a picture of it with your phone, bring it with you to Mass, and show it to one of the ushers.

SACRAMENTS



- Confessions will resume Saturdays @ 4:30 PM
 - They will be heard outside by the grotto with priest and penitent wearing face coverings
- Eucharist
 - When you come forward for Communion, wear your face covering. When receiving, flatten your hands, step to the side, remove face covering, consume the host, and cover your face again.
 - Only the Body of Christ will be distributed. It is *strongly encouraged* that Communion be received in the hand to protect you, those who receive after you, and the minister.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING & SAFETY PROTOCOL

- Ushers will escort you to the pre-arranged seats. Only members of the same household may sit together.
- Singing will be limited to cantor. There will be no printed Orders of Worship or missalettes.
- There will be no Entrance Procession, Offertory Procession, or Recessional
- Collection baskets will not be passed. Tithes and offerings may be placed in the designated basket near the gifts table in the center of the church.
- Sign of Peace is suspended until further notice.
- At the conclusion of mass, ushers will dismiss the assembly by rows.
- Coffee & fellowship after Mass remains suspended
- High-touch points & restrooms will be sanitized after each Mass.



MOST IMPORTANTLY



- Those who are sick, especially with any respiratory symptoms (fever, cough, sneezing, sore throat) should recuperate at home and not attend Mass.
- Those who are 65 and older and those with compromised immune systems should consider staying at home for their protection.
- The 9:30 AM Mass will be livestreamed and the Bishop's dispensation from the Sunday obligation remains in place for those who cannot attend Mass and those who fear exposure to infection.

Please note that each ticket counts as one head count per seat. For example, if you have a family of 4, set quantity of tickets to 4. Confirm quantity by clicking on "Register" once again
