CHURCH RE-OPENING

EFFECTIVE MAY 30, 2020

IN ORDER TO MINIMIZE THE RISK OF INFECTION & PROTECT ALL WHO ATTEND, WE HAVE PUT THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES IN PLACE:

MASSSES

- Weekend Mass schedule will remain the same
 - Sunday – 8:30 PM
 - Sunday – 7:30 AM, 9:30 AM, 6:00 PM
- Weekday Masses
 - Mon – Fri – 6:00 PM
 - Saturday morning mass will resume at a later date
- Max Capacity per Mass: 120 people



MASS RESERVATIONS ON EVENTBRITE.COM

- Reservations will open on Tuesdays at 12 noon
- 1 seat – 1 household
- Attendance at Mass will be limited to those we can accommodate with the 6ft physical distancing
- To manage attendance, you will need to register on [Eventbrite.com](https://www.eventbrite.com) to reserve your seat.
 - Only those who have reserved their seat on Eventbrite will be allowed to attend Mass.
- Masses will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. In light of your seat reservation, please arrive at Mass and show it to one of the ushers.

SACRAMENTS



- Communion will be available until 6:30 PM
 - There will be hand sanitizer, gloves, and plexiglass available
- Baptisms
 - When you come forward for Communion, wear your face covering. When looking toward your hands, to your side, remove face covering, consume the host, and cover your face again.
 - Only the Host of Christ will be distributed. It is strongly encouraged that Communion be received in the hand to protect you, those who receive after you, and the ushers.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING & SAFETY PROTOCOL

- Ushers will escort you to the pre-arranged seats. Only members of the same household may sit together.
- Singing will be limited to cantor. There will be no printed Orders of Worship or missalette.
- There will be no Entrance Procession, Offertory Procession, or Recessional.
- Collection baskets will not be passed. Tithes and offerings may be placed in the designated basket near the gifts table in the center of the church.
- Sign of Peace is suspended until further notice.
- At the conclusion of mass, ushers will dismiss the assembly by rows.
- Coffee & fellowship after Mass remains suspended.
- High-touch points & restrooms will be sanitized after each Mass.



MOST IMPORTANTLY



- Those who are sick, especially with any respiratory symptoms (fever, cough, sneezing, sore throat) should recuperate at home and not attend Mass.
- Those who are ill and older and those with compromised immune systems should consider staying at home for their protection.
- The 9:30 AM Mass will be livestreamed and the Bishop's discretion from the Family Litigation manual plan in those who are unable to attend Mass and those who fear exposure to infection.

1 VISIT OUR PARISH WEBSITE

Using an internet browser (Google Chrome, Safari, Firefox, etc.) go to www.stmichaelsthehill.org



2 CLICK ON EVENTBRITE

On the home page of our website, you are going to click on the Eventbrite button which will take you directly to our reservation page. If it does not load, type the following URL into the address bar: <https://bit.ly/2414NCP>



3 CLICK ON THE MASS YOU PLAN TO ATTEND

Daily masses and Sunday masses for the specific week will be listed on Eventbrite page. You will be led to a page that gives a description of the Mass you've selected. Confirm your selection by clicking on "Register"



4 SET QUANTITY

Please note that each ticket counts as one head count per seat. For example, if you have a family of 4, set quantity of tickets to 4. Confirm quantity by clicking on "Register" once again.



5 INSERT CONTACT INFO

Enter the First Name, Last Name, and Email Address of the main contact person reserving the tickets.



6 CLICK ON REGISTER

A confirmation email will be sent to your email after you have successfully registered! You have the option to view your tickets and/or print them. Please be ready to show your tickets upon entering the Church campus to our ushers.
