Lent - Lent has two major purposes: a) It recalls baptism or prepares for it; b) It emphasises a spirit of penance. Through forty days of closer attention to God's Word and more fervent prayer, believers are prepared to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. It is a preparation for Easter. Lent ends on Holy Thursday, as we begin the Sacred Paschal Triduum with the Mass of the Lord's Supper in the evening.

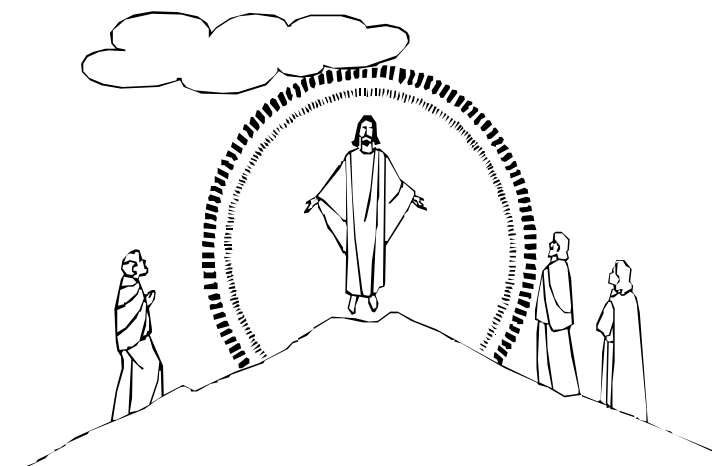
