Tips for Spiritual Living - Develop a habit of daily prayer using The Prayer Process. Search "The Prayer Process" on your phone, tablet or computer and use these steps to start or enrich a practice of daily prayer. For those who do not have computer access, the Prayer Process is as follows: **Gratitude:** Begin by thanking God in a personal dialogue for whatever you are grateful for today. **Awareness:** Revisit the times in the past twenty-four hours when you were, and were not, the best version of yourself. Talk to God about these situations and what you learned from them. **Significant Moments:** Identify something you experienced in the past 24 hours and explore what God might be trying to say to you through that event or person. **Peace:** Ask God to forgive you for any wrong you have committed (against yourself, another person or Him) and to fill you with deep and abiding peace. **Freedom:** Speak with God about how He is inviting you to change your life, so that you can experience the best version of yourself. **Others:** Lift up to God anyone you feel called to pray for today, asking God to bless and guide them. **Pray the Our Father. Take just 10 minutes a day and start a practice of daily reading using THE WORD AMONG US, a publication with daily readings and meditations to help understand and apply the Word of God in our daily lives.** Available as an app on iPhone/iPad, Android and Kindle or order paper edition online at wau.org/new4
