Tips for Spiritual Living - Develop a habit of daily prayer using The Prayer Process. It is as follows: **Gratitude:** Begin by thanking God in a personal dialogue for whatever you are grateful for today. **Awareness:** Revisit the times in the past twenty-four hours when you were, and were not, the best version of yourself. Talk to God about these situations and what you learned from then. **Significant Moments:** Identify something you experienced in the past 24 hours and explore what God might be trying to say to you through that event or person. **Peace:** Ask God to forgive you for any wrong you have committed (against yourself, another person or Him) and to fill you with deep and abiding peace. **Freedom:** Speak with God about how He is inviting you to change your life, so that you can experience the best version of yourself. **Others:** Lift up to God anyone you feel called to pray for today, asking God to bless and guide them. **Pray the Our Father.** Check out DECISION POINT with your teens . This program was specifically developed to engage young Catholics in a meaningful conversation about Catholicism. Developed as a Confirmation program in the US , it teaches and inspires teens to respond to God's grace. This series of short videos can be found at dynamiccatholic.com/confirmation.
