Please complete them as quickly as possible as the Archdiocese would like this process completed by mid March. Once completed and signed, return the forms to the church, the Parish Office (if after hours you can place the forms in an envelope and drop it in the mail slot of the parish office door.). Please note all forms (including the Policy Check forms) must be returned to us. You do not have to drop the Police Check form off to the RNC or pay any fee. Volunteers receive these free of charge and we will send the forms to them for you. If you have any questions, please contact the parish office or one of the committee members. Thank you for your patience and understanding in this matter.

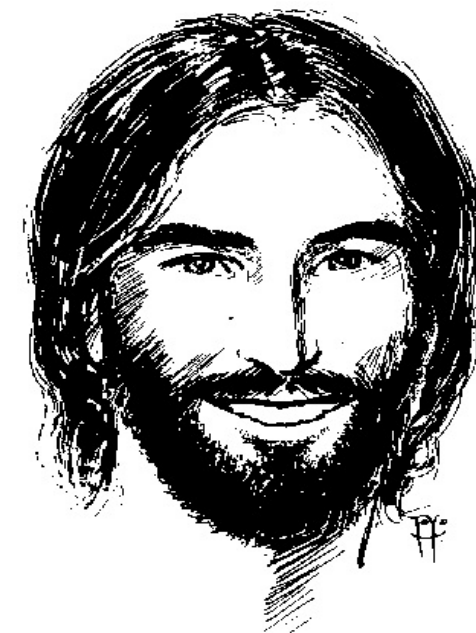
