Spiritual Tips - REDISCOVER THE MASS #9 - THE CONSECRATION

The Consecration is the moment when the bread and wine become the body and blood of Christ. This happens when the priest says "This is my body which is given up for you, do this is memory of me". During this time, simply allow yourself to be in the presence of God. Quiet your mind. Imagine yourself close to Jesus at the Last Supper. As the priest elevates the host say in your heart "My Lord and my God". These mysteries are mysteries but if we approach them humbly, often and with reverence, God will give us an everlasting love and understanding of them.
