St. Kevin's wishes everyone an enormous WELCOME BACK to Mass this weekend!!!

The past few months have been unbelievably challenging in so many ways and we have missed celebrating as a community.

As we return to Mass, it will be different to have no music, practice physical distancing and wear face masks as part of our Sunday best. After all the challenges we have faced in the past few months, this is a good time to return to Mass with a spirit of renewal and a new focus.

Why do we go to Mass? What can we get from it and what can we give?

This week at St Kevin's we challenge that as you walk in to Mass , pray " God, show me one way in this Mass I can become the best version of myself this week". Listen intently and focus on each part of the Mass . Start a Mass Journal and write down the one way God is challenging you to grow , change and become all he created you to be.

At the end of Mass, pray about how you can begin to live that one thing in the coming week.

NOTICE - RE-OPENING OF ST. KEVIN'S & ST. JOSEPH'S

Weekend Mass will resume in each parish on the weekend of July 11th & 12th.

There will be no weekday Masses at St. Kevin's for time being.

In Alert Level 2, as mandated by the Government we are permitted to have 50 people at each Mass, including Priest, Reader, Extraordinary Minister, Co-ordinator & 2 Ushers.

On Monday, July 6th from 9 am - 12 Noon & 1pm - 4 pm, we will be taking registration by phone only at the Parish Office for St. Kevin's Parish. (745-8183)

If you are calling to register for Mass at St. Joseph's Parish you must call one of the following people:

Please do not leave a message if you are calling to register at St. Kevin's, but call back as registration will be done on a first to call basis only. Our Parish Office is still closed to the public, so you cannot register in person.

We ask that you please have patience with this process as we are trying to be fair to all.

Because we are only allowed 50 people per Mass this will mean that it is possible you will not be able to attend Mass every weekend and unfortunately you will not have the option to choose which day (Saturday or Sunday) you would like to attend .

To give everyone the opportunity to attend a Mass we will be using a color code system. You will be assigned a color when you register and you will be asked to pick up a card of that color. You must take this card to Mass with you. This system will give everyone an opportunity to attend a Mass rather than line up outside taking the chance of not being one of the first 50.

All you will have to do is call the Parish Office at 745-8183 or visit our website at www.stjstk.ca every Friday to find out the color of each Mass for that weekend.

Example: If you are given a BLUE card that means when you check each week to find out the color code of each Mass, if the message says Saturday Mass is color BLUE then you can attend that Mass. If BLUE is not indicated for any of the Masses then you can not attend any Mass that weekend.

It will be very important that you call the Parish Office or visit our website for this information each week as you will only be permitted to enter the church if you have the colored card assigned for that Mass.

Message from the Archbishop

June 26, 2020

RE: Archdiocesan Guidelines for Public Worship at Alert Level 2

Dear People of the Archdiocese of St. John's:

The province announced on Wednesday that Alert Level 2 comes into effect on Thurs. June 25th.

At Alert Level 2: "Places of worship are permitted to resume operations with restrictions". These restrictions include:

- A maximum of 50 people at services,
- The need to observe physical distancing and enhanced sanitation protocols
- Recording contact information in case contact tracing may later be required.

To safely and responsibly open our churches and celebrate public worship under these conditions is going to require a great deal of preparation and supervision. With the above in mind, I bring the following points to your attention:

1. All people of the Archdiocese continue to be dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass.
2. No Parish is required to open immediately and no timeline is set for the opening of any parish church.
3. Each Parish Priest will need to determine whether and/or when his parish church can open for public worship and private visitation under these conditions.

I know the guidelines and restrictions that will need to be followed for the celebration of public worship during the time of Alert Level 2 will feel strange and uncomfortable. However, they are grounded in the desire and obligation to do everything we can to nurture the spiritual welfare of the Faithful of the Archdiocese while protecting them from the spread of COVID-19. Thanking you for your patience with and respect for the efforts being made by our parish priests and their staffs and volunteers to minister generously and responsibly during this time of pandemic,
