Since we are experiencing a Pandemic and as you know there are many restrictions surrounding it, this year's annual Remembrance of the Holy Souls who have passed away during the last 12 months will not take place in the church during Mass in the usual manner. However, the names of your loved ones who have died during the last year will be written on a scroll located in the of the church. Flowers will be kept in front of the scroll and one candle will be kept burning during the month of November. May they rest in Peace.

Also, please note that due to the COVID-19 restrictions there will not be a Book of Remembrance placed in the Church this year. However, there will be a weekly petition during November for all those who have died. Please say a prayer each day for all souls in Purgatory.

Adoration at St. Kevin's Church - There will be special Adoration with music and Confession on the 1st Tuesday of each month from 7:30 - 8:30 pm starting Tuesday, Nov. 3rd.

Mandatory Face Mask Wearing - Effective Mon., Aug. 24th, Government has made it mandatory that face masks be worn in all public places. Therefore, face masks must be worn by everyone entering, and moving around in church. When you are seated and are physically distanced (6 ft apart), you can remove your face mask until you leave your seat at Communion time and then again when leaving the church. Thank you for your cooperation.

Mass Intentions If you would like to request a Mass for a loved one. You can request an intention by phone, email or dropping by the Parish Office when open to the public. Or you can place your intention & money in an envelope and drop it in the mail slot of the Parish Office door.

Votive Candles - In light of the month of Holy Souls and given the fact that many requests have been made for the return of the lighting of votive candles, effective this weekend (Nov. 7th & 8th) we are placing the votive candle rack back in its place at the front of the church. However, the process for lighting the candles has changed. When you come into the church let the Coordinator know how many candles you would like lit and place your money in the container provided on the table. We ask that you bring to church the exact amount of money (candles are \$1 each) for the number of candles you want lit as we cannot provide change and are not permitted to handle money. Your candle(s) will be lit by an Usher before Mass begins. We thank you for your understanding during these unprecedented times.
