DRIVE BY DONATIONS FOR ST. KEVIN'S FOOD BANK - Hosted by St. Kevin's Kindness Committee. On *Sunday, December 6 and Sunday, December 13 from 1-3 p.m.*, members of our Parish Kindness Committee will be outside the front of our Parish Hall to accept non-perishable food items, grocery gift cards and monetary donations for our Food Bank. We will be wearing our masks and gloves. We ask that those driving by to drop off donations place them in the box provided by the steps. Then you can drive on. This is to comply with no contact and social distancing COVID protocols. Remember that our Food Bank serves all denominations in the Goulds, Petty Harbour and Maddox Cove areas. We hope to see a great turn out over the next two Sundays to donate to this very worthy cause. 2020 has been a very difficult year for so many. let's do our part to help.

Mandatory Face Mask Wearing Government has made it mandatory that face masks be worn in all public places. Therefore, face masks must be worn by everyone entering, and moving around in church. When you are seated and are physically distanced (6 ft apart), you can remove your face mask until you leave your seat at Communion time and then again when leaving the church.

Mass Intentions If you would like to request a Mass for a loved one. You can request an intention by phone, email or dropping by the Parish Office when open to the public. Or you can place your intention & money in an envelope and drop it in the mail slot of the Parish Office door.

Votive Candles - In light of the month of Holy Souls and given the fact that many requests have been made for the return of the lighting of votive candles, effective this weekend (Nov. 7th & 8th) we are placing the votive candle rack back in its place at the front of the church. However, the process for lighting the candles has changed. When you come into the church let the Coordinator know how many candles you would like lit and place your money in the container provided on the table. We ask that you bring to church the exact amount of money (candles are \$1 each) for the number of candles you want lit as we cannot provide change and are not permitted to handle money. Your candle(s) will be lit by an Usher before Mass begins. We thank you for your understanding during these unprecedented times.

St. Joseph's Sunday Missals - Missals have been shipped to us from the distributors in Toronto and we are hoping to have them next week. This year missals will have to be picked up at the Parish Office due to COVID restrictions on handling of materials by the public.
