Mandatory Face Mask Wearing Government has made it mandatory that face masks be worn in all public places. Therefore, face masks must be worn by everyone entering, and moving around in church. When you are seated and are physically distanced (6 ft apart), you can remove your face mask until you leave your seat at Communion time and then again when leaving the church.

Mass Intentions If you would like to request a Mass for a loved one. You can request an intention by phone, email or dropping by the Parish Office when open to the public . Or you can place your intention & money in an envelope and drop it in the mail slot of the Parish Office door.

Votive Candles - Given the fact that many requests have been made for the return of the lighting of votive candles, we have placed the votive candle rack back in its place at the front of the church. However, the process for lighting the candles has changed. When you come into the church let the Coordinator know how many candles you would like lit and place your money in the container provided on the table. We ask that you bring to church the exact amount of money (candles are \$1 each) for the number of candles you want lit as we cannot provide change and are not permitted to handle money. Your candle(s) will be lit by an Usher before Mass begins. We thank you for your understanding during these unprecedented times.
