WHAT'S HAPPENING AT CATALDO

Did you know that Cataldo Catholic School supports Cataldo families with quality child care before school, after school, and during the summer?

Cataldo's child care program, Cataldo Care, is licensed by the Washington Department of Children, Youth, and Families, and operates out of the preschool classrooms in the basement of the school. During the school year, we provide children from preschool through junior high before school and after school care with outside play, games, crafts, homework assistance, and other fun activities. The seamless connection between our students' teachers, their after school activities and their families is something we are very proud of.

During the summer, Cataldo provides another licensed program to children who are enrolled at Cataldo for the following school year. From June 17 through August 21, Cataldo Summer Care provides fun activities including Art Day and Water Day, as well as field trips and neighborhood adventures, from 6:55 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Each week has a theme, such as Ice Cream, Pool Noodle Fun, or Pirates and Princesses. The program is run by Lindsey Morse, Cataldo Care Director, as well as many amazing staff members who work in the Cataldo Preschool and in Cataldo Care during the school year.

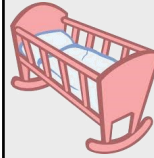
