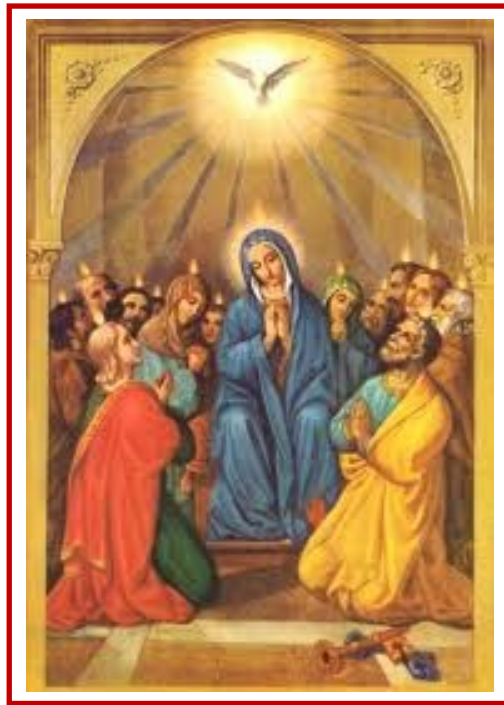

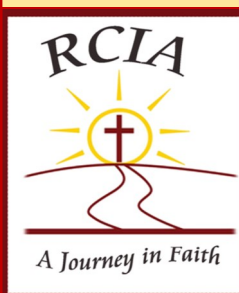

A letter with further information on these projects was mailed out this week. If you did not receive it, please contact the parish so we can update your address.

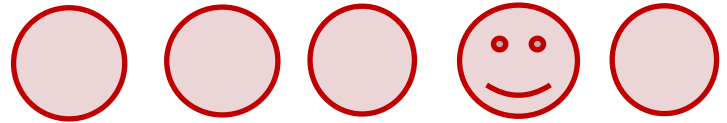
