Many of you commented that you appreciate the utilization of the piano as the primary instrument for worship. To that end, we are returning to the pattern of several years ago – two weekends each month will be piano weekends. The only variation in this pattern will happen when there are several feast weekends in a row, such as Ascension/Pentecost or Palm Sunday/Easter.

For those feast days, we will continue to use the organ as the primary instrument.

SUMMER PROJECTS AND COLLECTION



This summer, our three big projects are:

1. **Terraced Gardens & Grotto:** We are clearing out, pruning, and adding topsoil and new plantings. We will also add an energy efficient sprinkler system and update the look of the grotto and signage at the corner of 18th Avenue and Bernard.
2. **The Organ:** Our 1999 Martin Pasi pipe organ needs routine maintenance and repairs. We would like to use funds from the summer appeal to match the generous \$15,000 grant from the Flannery Trust for these repairs.
3. **Vestibule:** We plan to freshen up the entrance to the church with new paint, restore the terrazzo flooring, and install new carpet in the baptistery.
