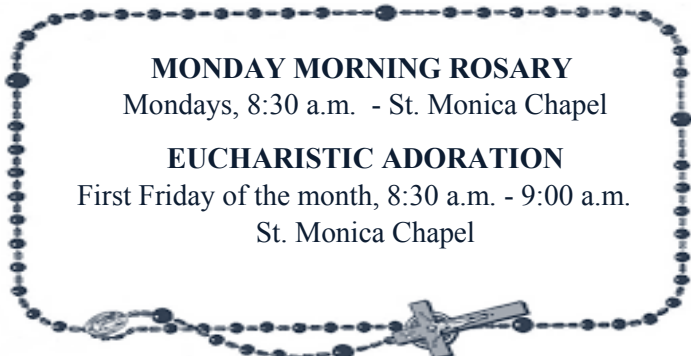

This is a wonderful program offered to students going into 6th grade through 9th grade. On Tuesdays and Thursdays, we offer service projects (ARC of Spokane, Second Harvest, House Of Charity, St. Anne's, etc.) and on Wednesdays we do fitness (bowling, wall climbing, CrossFit, hiking, etc.). We even offer a money camp at Wheatland Bank. We start at 8:30 a.m. and finish about noon.

### SUMMER PROJECTS AND COLLECTION

This summer, our three big projects are:



- Terraced Gardens & Grotto:** We are clearing out, pruning, and adding topsoil and new plantings. We will also add an energy efficient sprinkler system and update the look of the grotto and signage at the corner of 18th Avenue and Bernard.
- The Organ:** Our 1999 Martin Pasi pipe organ needs routine maintenance and repairs. We would like to use funds from the summer appeal to match the generous \$15,000 grant from the Flannery Trust for these repairs.
- Vestibule:** We plan to freshen up the entrance to the church with new paint, restore the terrazzo flooring, and install new carpet in the baptistery.
