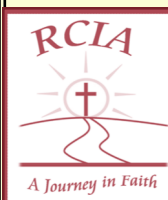

SUMMER PROJECTS UPDATE



1. **Vestibule:** Work has begun on the vestibule. Over the next several weeks, workers will paint the vestibule walls, hang new paneling in the baptistry, and remove carpet in the vestibule and around the font to expose the terrazzo floors. We hope to keep the disruption to a minimum and appreciate your patience as we work to refresh the space.
2. **Terraced Gardens & Grotto:** Work continues on the parish grounds. You may have noticed new perennials coming to life. We have planted rhododendrons on 18th Avenue. The sprinkler system has now been repaired and is working well. The Sorrows of Mary statues now have lighting and personalized plaques at each, with a special plaque for Mothers of Lost Children in the area at the northeast corner of the parking lot near the Pieta and Crucifix.
3. **The Organ:** An assessment has been made regarding the required repairs. Some minor repairs are already completed and other work on the organ will begin in the next several weeks.
