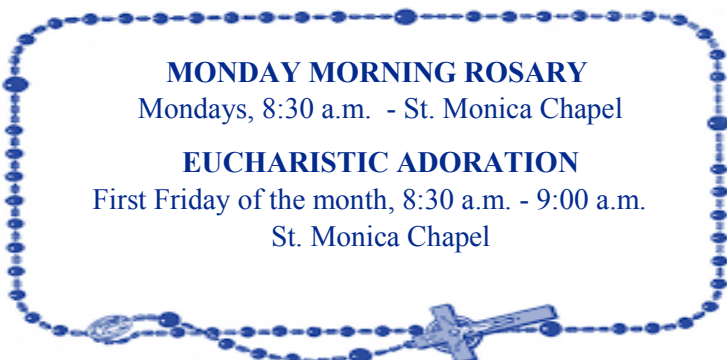

## SUMMER PROJECTS UPDATE



1. **Vestibule:** Work is continuing in the vestibule. Over the last several weeks, workers have painted the vestibule walls, hung new paneling in the baptistery, and removed carpet in the vestibule and around the font to expose the terrazzo floors. We hope to keep the disruption to a minimum and appreciate your patience as we work to refresh the space.
2. **Terraced Gardens & Grotto:** Work continues on the parish grounds. You may have noticed new perennials coming to life. We have planted rhododendrons on 18th Avenue. The sprinkler system has now been repaired and is working well. The Sorrows of Mary statues now have lighting and personalized plaques at each, with a special plaque for Mothers of Lost Children in the area at the northeast corner of the parking lot near the Pieta and Crucifix.

**The Organ:** The Bond Organ Company will be at St. Augustine this week to begin repair work on the organ. The first goal will be alleviation of sticking notes that has plagued us for quite some time. Further information will be included in the next few weeks about the second stage of the repair project.
