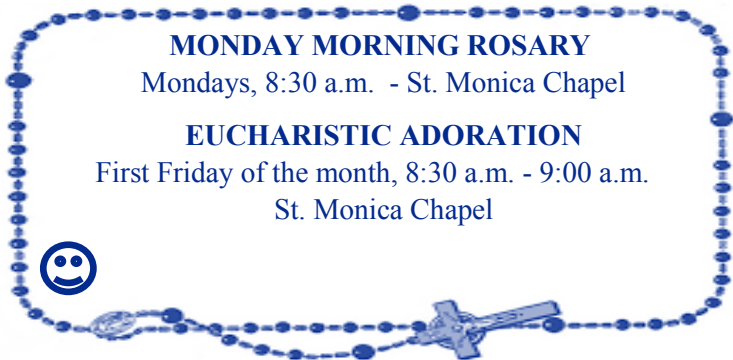

## SUMMER PROJECTS UPDATE



**Vestibule:** The work in the vestibule is nearly complete. Over the last several weeks, workers have painted the walls, hung new paneling in the baptistery, and removed carpet in the vestibule and around the font to expose the terrazzo floors. We hope to keep the disruption to a minimum and appreciate your patience as we work to refresh the space.

**Terraced Gardens & Grotto:** Work continues on the parish grounds. You may have noticed new perennials coming to life. We have planted rhododendrons on 18th Avenue. The sprinkler system has now been repaired and is working well. The Sorrows of Mary statues now have lighting and personalized plaques at each, with a special plaque for Mothers of Lost Children in the area at the northeast corner of the parking lot near the Pieta and Crucifix.

**The Organ:** This past week, the Bond Organ Company began repair work on the organ. In this first stage, they focused on alleviating the sticking notes that have plagued our musical ears for quite some time. Further information will be included in the next few weeks about the second stage of the repair project.
