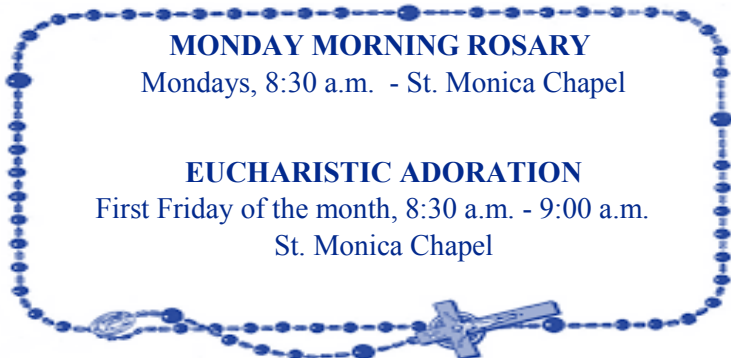

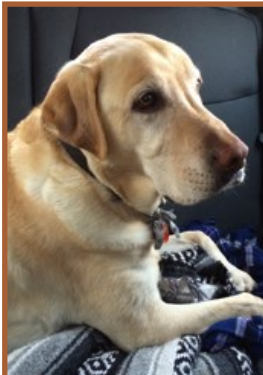

SUMMER PROJECTS UPDATE



Vestibule: The work in the vestibule is nearly complete. Over the last several weeks, workers have painted the walls, hung new paneling in the baptistry, and removed carpet in the vestibule and around the font to expose the terrazzo floors. We hope to keep the disruption to a minimum and appreciate your patience as we work to refresh the space.

Terraced Gardens & Grotto: Work continues on the parish grounds. You may have noticed new perennials coming to life. We have planted rhododendrons on 18th Avenue. The sprinkler system has now been repaired and is working well. The Sorrows of Mary statues now have lighting and personalized plaques at each, with a special plaque for Mothers of Lost Children in the area at the northeast corner of the parking lot near the Pieta and Crucifix.

The Organ: The Bond Organ Company has completed the first portion of the repairs on the organ. They have made some adjustments so that the notes and pedals are not “sticking” as they had been doing previously. They also performed some routine tuning and regulation that should be regularly done if the organ is to remain in good condition. They will return after the heat has passed and into winter to continue repairs.
