Be sure to catch up on chats and calories with other parishioners by joining us for coffee and donuts in the gym after the Sunday Masses.

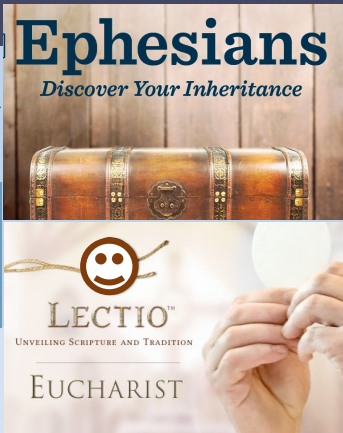
