ACA UPDATE

St. Augustine Parish has \$82,628 as a goal. To date, we contributed \$51,460 (62%) toward this goal. So far, 24% of families have contributed to the ACA so far. If each family participates in supporting the diocese, we will achieve and exceed this goal. When this happens, the overage is returned to the parish. Last year, we exceeded our goal by \$20,000, which allowed us to make improvements around the parish. The ACA supports vocations, priest retirement, Newman Centers, Catholic schools, prison ministry and more.

**A PEEK AT CATALDO'S
KINDERGARTEN**

Kindergarten at Cataldo Catholic School includes twenty-six students who are engaged in actively learning about God our Creator, Jesus our friend and the Holy Spirit our helper. Kindergarteners learn to tell stories through illustrations that assist their verbal interpretation of an event. Our writing is in the beginning phase of reviewing letter sounds and blending those sounds into words. Never has there been a more concerted effort at a task than when a kindergartener picks up a pencil and attempts to form letters and numbers the way the big kids do. The kindergarteners focus on the most basic addition and subtraction skills and explore number patterns in the calendar. They love learning about fairytales, observing nature and animals in science and discovering how God made us with wonderful similarities and differences. Kindergarteners are also constantly learning about people. They learn what they can do for others by looking at the people around them and how God created us to be a part of this wonderful world as we follow Jesus.



CEPHAS is a lay founded ministry that strengthens the Catholic identity at Cataldo Catholic School and nurtures the spiritual formation of the entire Cataldo community, including its member parishes.

Through events and activities, CEPHAS strives to inspire the entire parish/school family to deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ and experience the community of the faithful more actively in their life.
