ORIGINAL CATHOLIC CEMETERY Schneider Road, Freedom Township, Washtenaw County, MI

Rumored to once have been the site of a Catholic mission, this small abandoned cemetery is located on the west side of Schneider Road, .2 miles south of Pleasant Lake Road, at the intersection of Hieber Road. While neglected for many years, it has been cleaned up and the stones are visible from the street. Readings are by Mrs. George Ross of Ann Arbor, and printed in the 1960 Summer issue of the Detroit Society for Genealogical Research magazine on pages 180 and 181.

5. Riedel, Jacob, (stone broken)
6. Disa – Merz A., age 73 (stone broken)
7. O’Neal, Bridget, age 35. Died July 11, 1857. Native of Ireland, Parish of Croon, County of Limerick.
8. Dougherty, Ellen, Dau of John & Ellen Dougherty. Age 20y, 1m, 2d. Died Dec. 18, 1855
9. Reiss, Catherina, dau of P & AM Reiss. Born Aug. 21, 1866, d. Mar. 5, 1869
10. Flynn, Matthew, age 18y, 8m. Died Aug. 21, 1859 (stone broken)
11. Drew, James, son of Micha & Ann Drew. Age 11y, 9m. Died Sept. 22, 1852
12. Ryan, James, age 21y, 19d. Died Apr. 30, 1851
13. Welsh, Margaret, age 52y. Died Mar. 6, 1855
14. Graff, Johann, alter 41 jahr. Died Feb 21, 1862
15. Dettling, Anna Slasia (?), Geb. Apr. 19, 1829, Gest. Feb. 8, 1861
16. Von Weik, John, age 5m, 2d. Son of P & M Von Weik. Born Apr. 12, 1865
