THE REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION IS TO HAVE HALF OF THE COST IN CASH IN THE BANK AND WE SURPASSED THAT AMOUNT THANKS TO THE GENEROSITY OF OUR PARISHIONERS BUT STILL HAD TO BORROW ENOUGH FOR COMPLETION OF PHASE I.

YOUR NEW ENVELOPES WILL SAY LOAN PAYMENT RATHER THAN CAPITAL CAMPAIGN. PLEASE HELP US WITH OUR MONTHLY PAYMENT. ONCE THIS LOAN IS PAID IN FULL WE CAN START THE PROCESS OF PHASE II OF OUR COMPLETE PROJECT.

In addition to the guidelines we are following we are also asking for help to sanitize the pews and chairs after all masses. There are spray bottles and rags in the back of the worship area. Your help is greatly appreciated.

**NEXT WEEKEND there will be a special collection for the Holy Land.** This annual Pontifical Good Friday Collection is mandated by the Holy Father to be taken up in every Catholic parish. The collection did not happen during the normal time of Good Friday this year due to COVID-19.

The Collection sustains Christianity in the Holy Land. With your support, the Franciscans maintain the sacred shrines throughout the Holy Land so that pilgrims can walk in the footsteps of Jesus. In addition, the Franciscan friars minister in parishes, provide formation and education, build homes, provide jobs, take care of the elderly, and feed the hungry.
